Minutes of the April 1, 2019 Joint VNC Board & DFC Focus on Children Meeting

 - Sandy spoke of the Venice ArtWalk ~ the idea of SPY folks being docents for the art walk, and she is doing follow up for this process.
 - Regan brought up the homelessness encampment adjunct to the library and the farmer's market and how
 it impacts families' use of these wonderful resources. Rachel Bindman refuted the negative health rumors
 about this community, but people spoke to whether anything is accurate or not, people are deterred.

Joelle spoke of their project as a source of creativity and renewal to honor the presence of children in Venice. They host 4-5 events annually. Have been at Venice H.S. for 34 years encouraging students to excel. They hold a luncheon for parents, community, school superintendent, etc. to publicly honor students. In December they do giveaway bags, in May they do a teacher gratitude/Oscar like event, honoring exemplary teachers, winners chosen by fellow staff members.

Paul spoke to the duration of these meetings, to shorten them. Everyone agreed.

 Paul: VNC Board's disposition of our <u>Youth Internship Program Motion</u> and an update on the work of his subcommittee

Paul gave an internship update: Gwendoline met with Dr. Renisha Scott at Venice H.S. An initial small pilot program will be launched, with the plan to overbook with 4 students in order to actually get 2 to commit. They will look into the work experience program which already exists.

Discussion about Jose Articles, leading admin for a citywide Work Experience program for teens. He and Paul have been communicating, and he is happy to meet Paul later in the week. Paul extended an open invitation for people to attend this meeting.

It was noted that it is highly recommended to have a contract of expectations and clearly defined tasks for the internship program. Paul passed around resources/info regarding work experience and internships.

Paul will continue future updates. Joe reported that the Board unanimously endorsed the internship initiative ~ it was noted that "ongoing ombudsmanship" with the Board is necessary and it is great that we are starting off with a positive unanimous front.

Regan - said that there is a similar program at Wildwood and the internships are highly coveted by students.

Sandy spoke of her Beverly Hills teacher contact and will give her information to Paul.

o Joe: Summary of Admin members' organization and purpose

Joe gave the administrative meeting report. Everyone is welcome to offer items for the agenda. People were reminded that if they introduce new initiatives, it is also a part of that process to choose specific point people/facilitators to push each particular effort forward.
