6. Discussion Re: Parking Meters Tickets - 200 block of Main St.

Motion: VNC recommends to LADOT and CD11 removal of multiple stall meters and replace with single stall meters. Whereas the existing multiple stall meters are slow to respond and often give the public misunderstood information about when they expire. And whereas, business customers are being charged with parking violations unjustly; and whereas businesses are losing customers as a result of malfunctioning meters; and whereas multiple stall meters are difficult to operate and often give customer false information. 7. Discussion Re: Proposed pedestrian crossing Pacific Ave at 27th Ave.

Motion: VNC Recommend to CD11 and LADOT parking restrictions on Pacific Av from SM border to Windward Av be removed on weekends starting at 8:00 PM on Friday evening and ending at 8am on Monday morning. (6,0,0)

Whereas: Overwhelming evidence that Pacific Ave is a hazard to pedestrian and drivers alike; and whereas: public need and necessity to correct the current situation and whereas: PTC recommends the VNC send the following: a letter to LADOT and CD11 requesting the following:

- 1. Immediate traffic enforcement
- 2. Immediate parking 24/2 (weekends) in both directions to help create a safety buffer for pedestrian
