Metro Sound Study (James Murez on behalf of Parking & Transportation Committee)



9D Streetscape, Landscape and Sidewalks (james.murez@venicenc.org)

MOTION: Whereas streets and sidewalks are getting new underground services and temporary patches are being used to restore these public thoroughfares, and whereas the temporary surfaces do not match the original materials and elevations often leave a bumpy and unsafe condition for pedestrians, scooters and bicycles, and whereas many of these temporary patches are located along high access areas, and whereas many of these improvements are being done to newly created sidewalks and streets leaving patched long term substandard surfaces, and whereas public improvements such as new street lighting, traffic control devices and storm water management projects are funded to include restoring surface to LA City Standards, and whereas privately owned public utility companies providing Metro Bike, kiosk billboard, LTE, 5G and wireless services pay the City to add equipment which includes restoring City property to original or better condition as defined in City Standards, and whereas streets are not being restored to original or better condition to city standards, therefore let it be resolved that,

MOTION: Whereas, the City of Los Angeles is hard pressed to maintain the many street medians and parkway areas in Venice, and Whereas, the resident group Neighbors of Grand has landscaped the southern median at the intersection of East Grand Blvd. and North Venice Blvd. at considerable time and expense, and It's YOUR Venice - get involved and Whereas, this community garden significantly enhances the neighborhood and this entrance to Venice, and Whereas, Neighbors of Grand is committed to continuing to water, prune and maintain the garden free from trash, and Whereas, it is problematic to stretch a water hose across East Grand Blvd. each time the garden needs to be watered (one hose has already been ruined by the tires of a large truck), Therefore, be it resolved, that the Venice Neighborhood Council recognizes and applauds the creation of the East Grand Blvd. community median garden, calls upon the Bureau of Street Services to coordinate any and all of its activities regarding the garden with the Neighbors of Grand, and asks the Bureau of Street Services to provide water to the site, from the median of Venice Blvd., in a locked box from which a drip irrigation system may be installed and administered by Neighbors of Grand to Allow for the healthy growth of this garden.
