This letter is to verify your exempt status and the fact that the determination letter issued in August 1979 continues to be in effect.

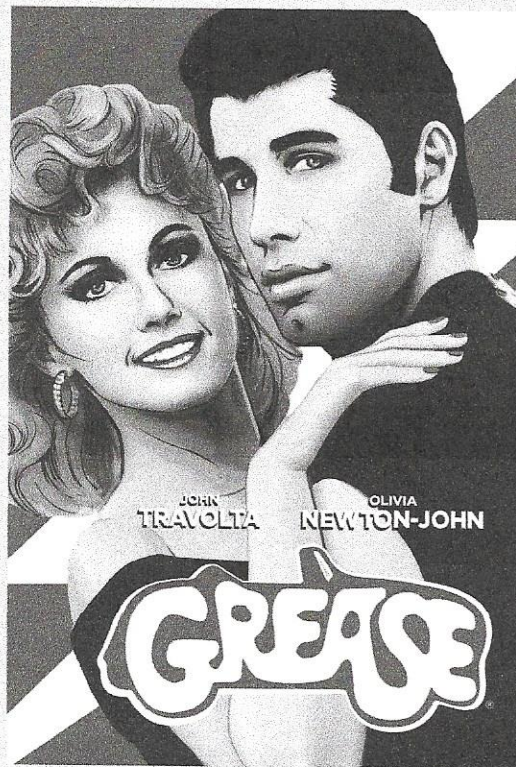
