Description: WHEREAS, the City previously passed a Safe Sidewalks Program, which has never been significantly activated in Venice.

WHEREAS, Previous requests have been made by this Committee to upgrade sidewalks in Venice that are in bad need of repair and are unsafe for pedestrian passage, and these requests have gone completely unacknowledged and unaddressed.

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2021, President Biden signed into law the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, which provides funding for sidewalk repair.

WHEREAS, the new City Council will approve the FY 2023-2024 budget in about May 2023, and funds should be also be available in CD11's AB1290 Fund and/or CD11's Real Property Trust Fund.

Description: WHEREAS, in 1999, the Los Angeles City Charter established the Neighborhood Council System and the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment which supports the Neighborhood Councils "to promote more citizen participation in government and make government more responsive to local needs..." Charter Section 900 and in 2001 created the Plan for Citywide System of Neighborhood Councils, which was adopted by the City and last updated in 2013. > WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Charter has not been significantly updated in almost 25 years and the Plan for Neighborhood Councils Neighborhood Council has not been significantly updated in 10 years; and

WHEREAS, redistricting of Neighborhood Councils is expected to occur in 2023.
