## **Election 2023 Related Information**

- What is the date for the election?
  - Venice Neighborhood Council, Region 11 should have their election on Sunday, March 26, 2023, but that is subject to the Office of the City Clerk to provide a detailed timeline for the NC elections since each NC Region is staggered.
- What is the timeline to become a candidate?
  - Filing to become a candidate generally is 120 days before Election Day. So, if Sunday, March 26, 2023 is the Venice NC Election Date, then 120 days before that date should be Saturday, November 26, 2022. But please check with the Elections Administrator from the Office of the City Clerk since they will have a more accurate and detailed timeline for the NC elections.
- Will this be an in-person voting affair or will there be VBM (vote by mail)?
  - The Neighborhood Council elections will be in-person polling places, and the option to vote by mail for every NC.
- Will the LA City Clerk provide all registered voters a ballot or will they need to apply for one?
  - That is a great question that can be addressed by the City Clerk's Election Administrator for Venice NC, which can be found in the following link:

- When will the terms of the current officers expire?
  - Venice Neighborhood Council Board Member Term Expiration is 2023, since the whole Board is up for election.
