Therefore Be It Resolved that the VNC Board supports the Lava Mae shower program in Venice with the following conditions:

- A medical professional is on hand to diagnose, treat, and prescribe medications to combat communicable diseases
- Lava Mae will provide quarterly updates on the success of the program to the community at VNC meetings
- The VNC will be consulted on any changes of use or intensity of the current program
- Lava Mae considers changing the day of service so it doesn't conflict with the Friday clean up at 3rd and Rose

C Health Official Encampment Inspection, (William Hawkins, <u>william.hawkins@venicenc.org</u>) (15 minutes)

**MOTION:** Whereas the City and the County of Los Angeles are responsible for the health and welfare of its citizens, and

Whereas the City and the County of Los Angeles to date have been unable to solve the homeless issue, and

Whereas there is a perceived public health concern within the community and proper care is needed to ensure the safety and well being of all those living in Los Angeles whether they be housed or unhoused

Therefore Be It Resolved that the VNC Board requests:

1. That the County of Los Angeles, the State of California, the Clty of Los Angeles and the Federal Government fulfill their fiduciary responsibility to all of its citizens ensuring that



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all housed and unhoused citizens are afforded the ability to have access to medical care as needed and;

- 2. That all trucks used for homeless showering be properly stored, sanitized and verified for contaminants, in accordance with Los Angeles County Health regulations and;
- 3. That the County immediately notify the VNC in writing of any reported outbreaks of MRSA in the VNC geographical area.

In addition, the VNC requests that the Los Angeles County Health Department conduct immediate and periodic health inspections on homeless encampments on Rose Avenue and throughout Venice to ensure the health and safety of all in the area.
