Parks and Recreation continues to do maintenance on the Westminster Dog Park. One area of concern was that dogs were getting splinters due to dry wood chips that were used as ground cover. To remedy this, sprinklers have been installed to improve moisture. A report from Bob Davis shows that there is now six inches of moist soil. The most soil will help when new ground cover is installed.

Watering will continue to maintain new wood chips when they are installed. A temporary fence was installed in the small dog park area to increases the size of the small dog park to 1,320 square feet. The small dog park will serve dogs under 25 pounds and timid dogs. The footage overall is 4,700 square feet. Permanent fences will be put in when the test study is done.

The committee is also working on getting a dog park map to identify new park benches and other items to enhance the park. These items will be a part of upcoming fundraising efforts.
