5. 2028 LA OLYMPICS SKATE VENUE (James Murez)

Whereas, Venice Beach is recognized around the world as a visitor destination;

Whereas, outdoor recreational roller skating and skateboarding began at Venice Beach as far back as the 1960's;

Whereas, Venice is home to many internationally recognized skaters, manufacturers, and retail businesses;

Whereas, Venice's Ocean Front Walk recreation park has 238 acres of open space in which to create a skateboard venue and includes over 2000 parking spaces contained in five LADOT lots;

Whereas, the Venice region has ample mass transportation which presently includes two Metro bus routes, two Big Blue bus routes and one Culver Green bus line, plus an ever expanding network of bike lanes including the Marvin Braude Coastal Bike Route which extends 22 miles from Palos Verdes to Pacific Palisades; and

Whereas the Venice business and tourism industry took a heavy beating during COVID-19 and an early decision to locate the LA28 Skateboard Venue in Venice will provide an economic boost to the region;

Therefore, the Board of Officers moves to send a letter to Mayor Bass, Councilwoman Park and the Ad Hoc Committee on the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games requesting the LA28 Skateboard Venue be located in Venice and furthermore, requests that these individuals make a formal request to the LA28 Olympic Organizing Committee.

Whereas the recently arrived "Tuk Tuk" brand of scooters are currently operating on the boardwalk and bike path.
