- b. Tree and Biodiversity Planning and the City's Urban canopy and tree Canopy Coverage; 15-0499-S-2 Report Back

VArb passed the following motion for submittal to the VNC:

Whereas, as part of a City Council file 15-0499-S-2, the City Council has adopted a report from the Planning and Land Use Management Committee which was an extensive report to maximize the City's efforts to grow tree canopy coverage and manage biodiversity; and related matters;

Whereas, the City Council further directed the City Attorney, the Bureau of Street Services, and the Board of Public Works, to report and provide recommendations on some proposed amendments to the City's Protected Tree Ordinance and whereas these recommendations would address situations such as the destruction of the Western Sycamore trees on Venice Blvd. and the withholding of building permits to rectify that type of infraction;

Whereas, there is great present urgency for biodiversity planning in the face of continued and rapid city-wide canopy reduction and as there are species exclusively living in the Los Angeles Basin that face reduced population due to current outdated practices;

Therefore, VNC moves to show support for the City Council's motion to adopt the Planning and Land Use Management Committee recommendations and it's proposed amendments, AND the VNC requests that the report back ordered from the City Attorney, the Bureau of Street Services and the Board of Public Works on file number 15-0499-S-2 be required in a timely fashion of 60 days from this motion.
