APPROVAL of PRIOR MINUTES: Motion to approve minutes of November 9th committee meeting.

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT: Comments from the public on non-agenda items within the Budget Committee's subject matter jurisdiction.

OLD BUSINESS: Chair Report Reports/updates: application submitted to use Westminster School for Jan-June Board meetings (expense is within approved budget) Empower is currently in discussion with the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) to explore how Neighborhood Councils (NCs) can optimize their use of LAUSD facilities for meetings. Will continue to follow up on this and the \$90 admin fee LAUSD is charging. No progress has been made to replace Constant Contact with a less expensive vendor. Status of Venice Heritage Museum NPG: entity is still listed as delinquent on Attorney General's Charity Registry-see November agenda/minutes for further details, this NPG will remain on hold until this issue is resolved. Board Approved NPG for Verdant Venice and LA City Clerk also approved and issued check.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Review of MER and Excel Budget Spreadsheet-see supporting documents
- 2. Motion: The VNC Board of Officers approves the November 2023 Monthly Expenditure Report (MER). (See supporting documents)
- 3. Discussion and possible motion to have VNC Board support Empower budget proposal to provide LA City-provided public email addresses for all NC board members and file a CIS when Council file is available. This proposal is included in Empower's Budget proposal for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 These addresses would be Google GSuite addresses, so that they can be used with the Gmail desktop or mobile app. According to Empower, these emails would give credibility to NC messaging, and would allow NC members to be protected from phishing and spam. VNC currently spends approx.\$220/month for 35 e-mail accounts.
- 4. Discussion: How/when to publicize NPG/CIP money, when to calculate our projected carryover based on savings and how much to recommend as a carryover in to election year.
