Who may vote: Stakeholders who are at least 16 years of age and live, work or own real property within the respective stated neighborhood boundaries of the VNC as defined in Article III, Section 2 of the bylaws.

WHO MAY VOTE: Stakeholders who do not live, work or own real property within the boundaries who are 18 years or older and who affirm a substantial and ongoing participation within the Neighborhood Council's boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations. Any Stakeholder, who is at least 16 years of age, and lives, works or owns real property within the boundaries of the VNC or is a Community Interest Stakeholders (as defined in Article IV of the bylaws).
