### 7. MOTION TO INSTALL FENCE BARRIERS ON OCEAN FRONT WALK

#### WHEREAS

1. Motorized vehicles on Ocean Front Walk are dangerous to pedestrians using the walk.
2. Installing fence barriers, such as the ones shown on the attachment to this Motion, at the north and south ends of Ocean Front Walk and places in between, which afford entrance to Ocean Front Walk such as Windward Avenue, would decrease motorized vehicles on Ocean Front walk and would be inexpensive to purchase and easy to install and to remove in emergencies.

#### NOW THEREFORE

3. The Venice Neighborhood Council requests the City to purchase and install sufficient fence barriers on Ocean Front Walk at the locations identified in Para. 2 to block motorized vehicles from entering Ocean Front Walk.
4. Upon passage of this resolution, the VNC Council will forward it to the offices of Councilwoman Park, the Manager of the Los Angeles Department of Parks and Recreation and the Commanders of the LAPD and LAFD stations for Venice.
