

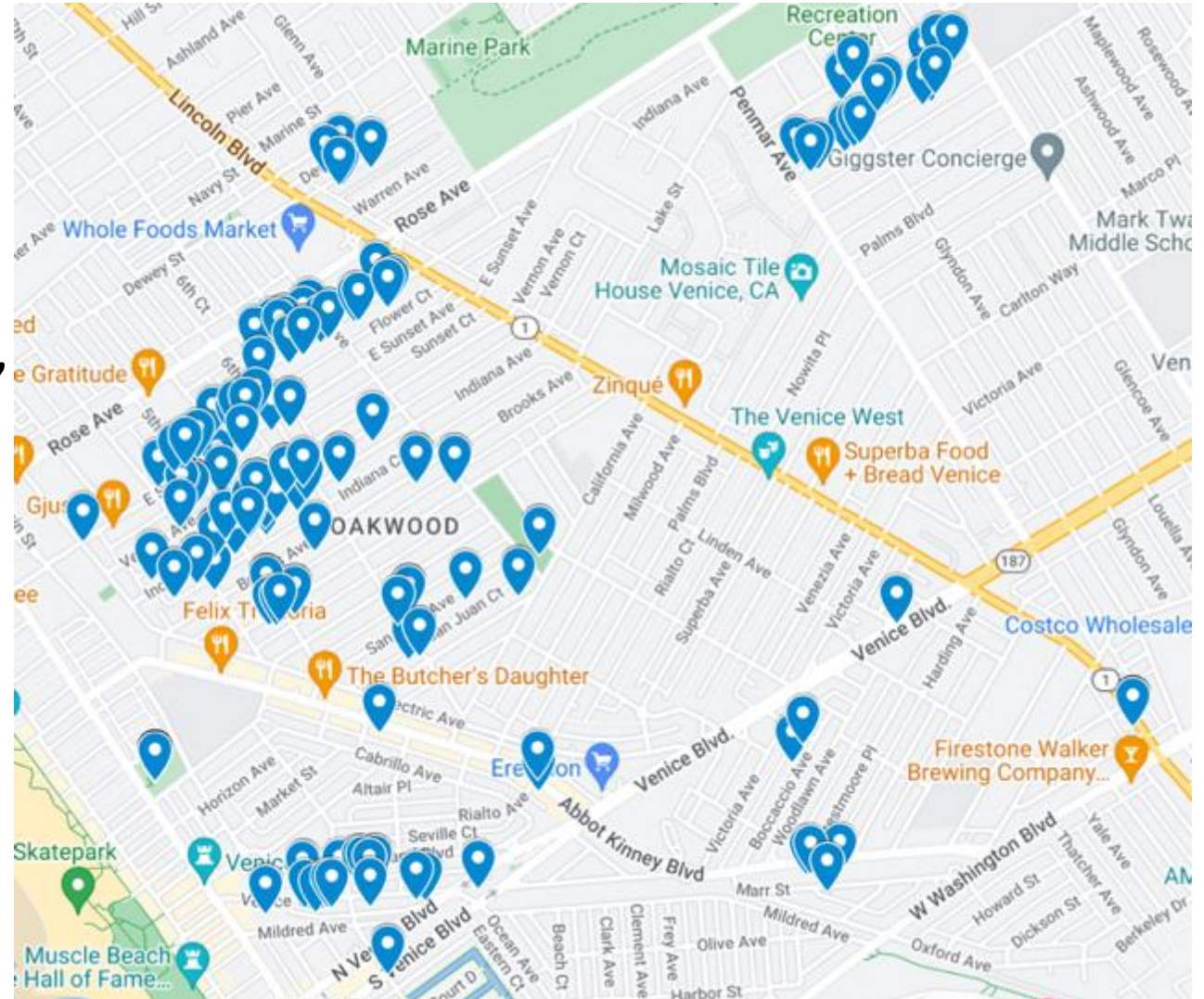

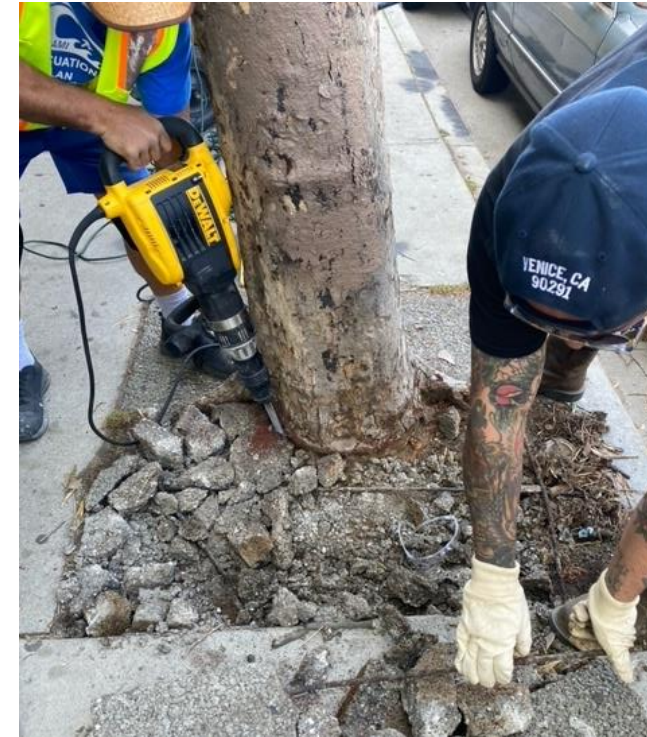
VERDANT VENICE GROUP AND PARTNERSHIPS

We have planted over 672 trees in partnership with many City agencies, such as LA Recreation and Park, LAUSD, LADOT, City Plants, Urban Forestry, Public Works, MWD, Golf Division, Venice Beach BID, and City of Santa Monica to plant trees and native understory plants that support our trees.

VVG is particularly focused on underserved Venice areas, such as the oakwood neighborhood.

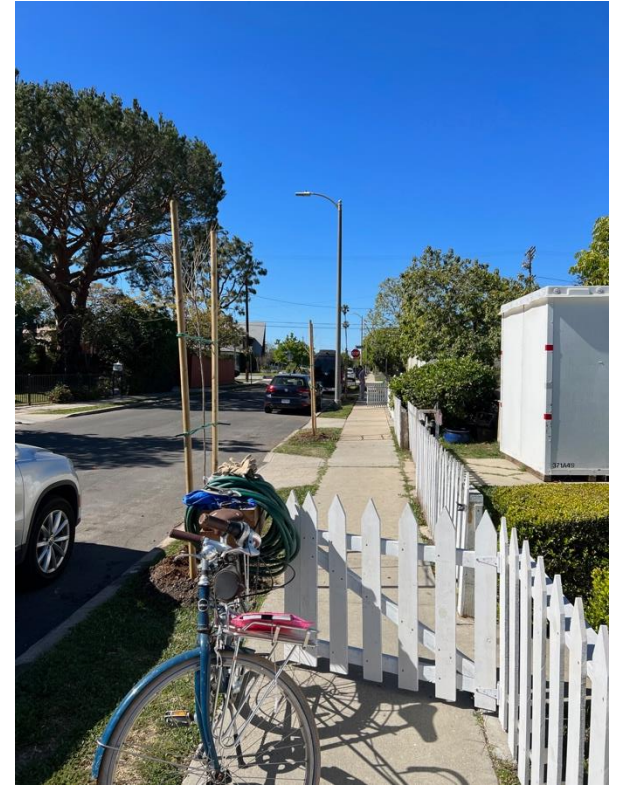


Agroperm Removal, Venice Blvd - Urban Forestry



VVG removed agroperm or permeable concrete from more than 75 sycamores trees over two years. We mulched and watered the trees. UFD picked up the concrete.

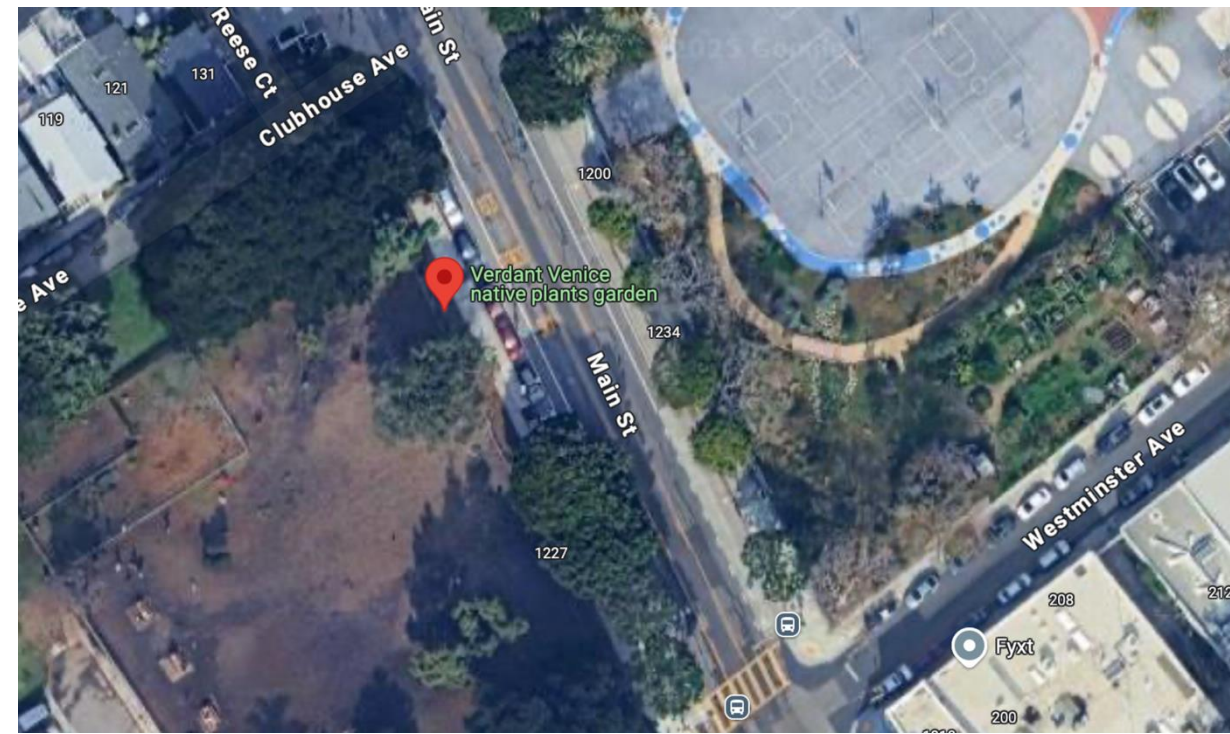

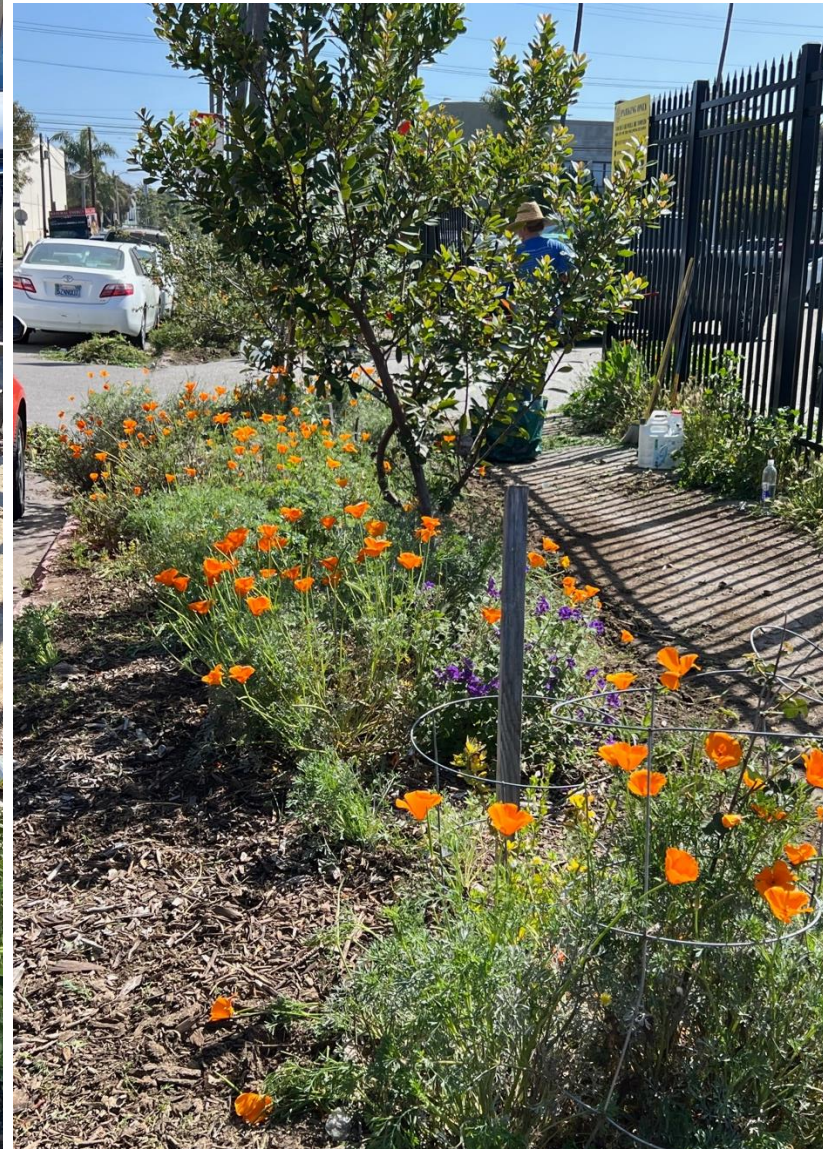

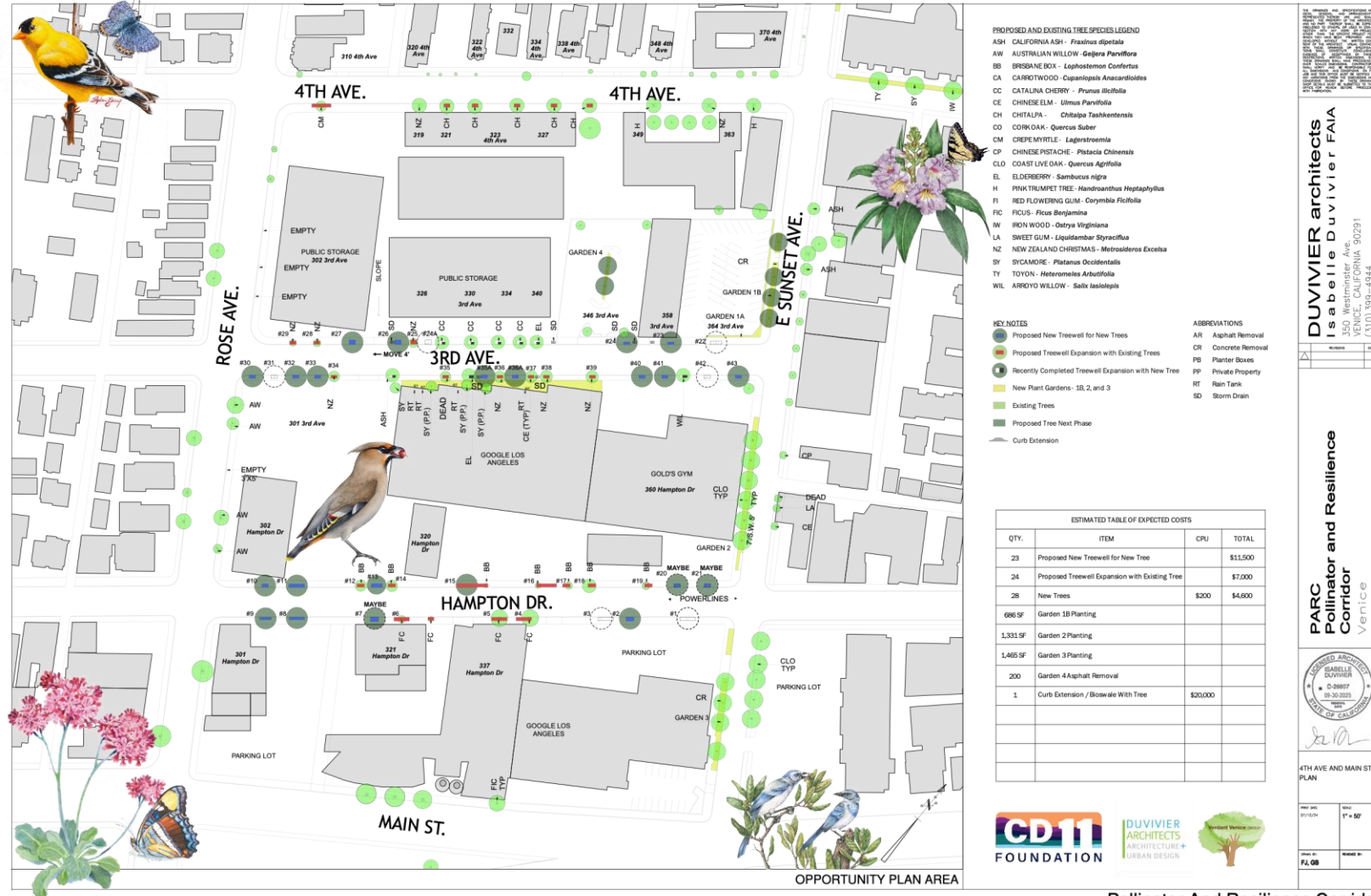

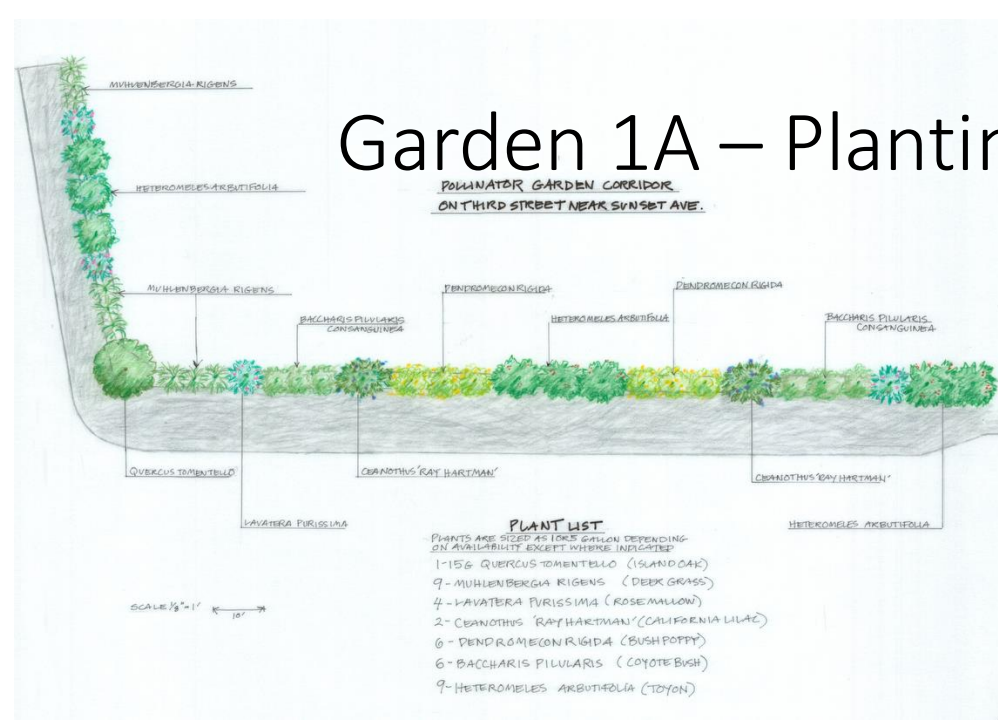


PARC – Pollinator and Resilience Corridor – with Partners: VVG, CD11, Venice Beach Business Improvement District

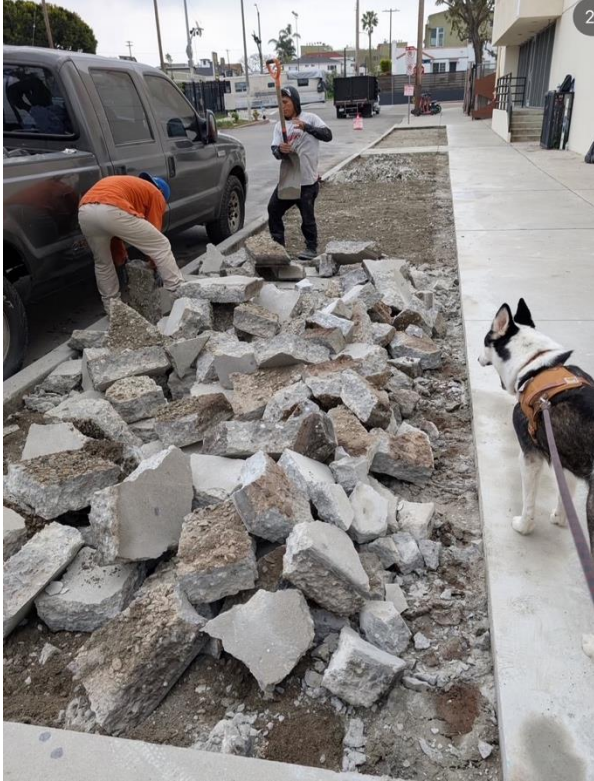




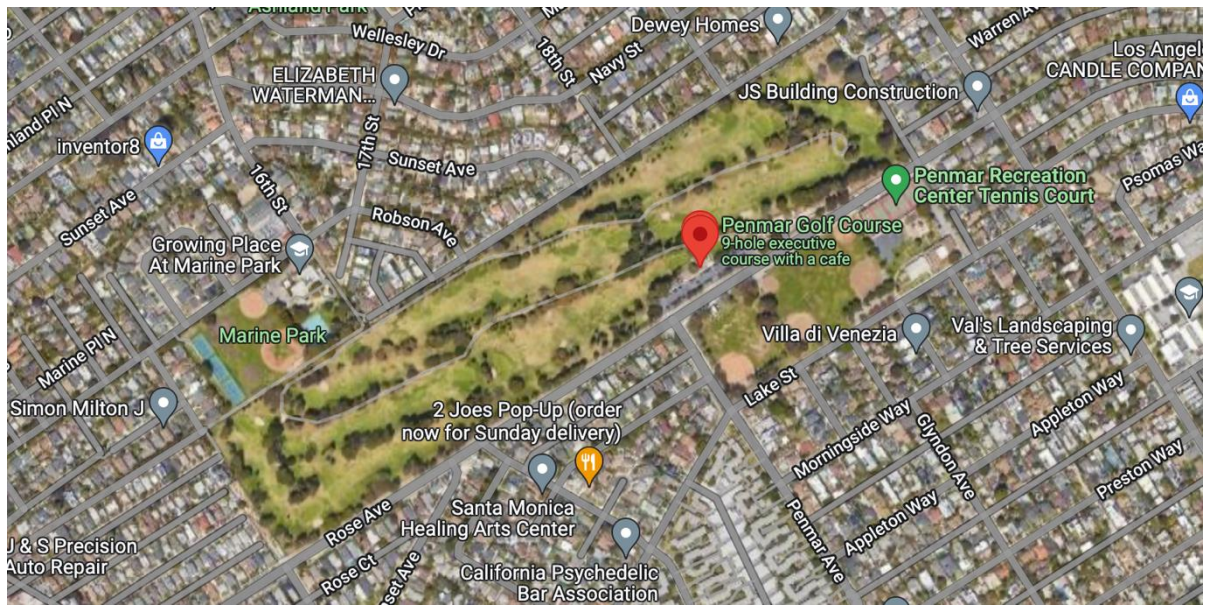
