POSSIBLE MOTIONS:

There are approximately 30 pending motions which include:

1. Multiple (Often Overlapping) Motions to Amend the by-laws submitted by the Rules Committee, Stakeholders and The Finance Committee

(This may constitute as many as 4-10 separate motions depending on how it is all parsed but is listed as a single item here)

2. Support Great Park Coalition; endorse Santa Monica Airport conversion to park.
3. Create Ad Hoc Youth Civic & Cultural Engagement Committee, sunset January 2027.
4. Support speed camera installation on Venice Blvd and Washington Blvd.
5. Request city develop Ocean Front Walk cultural preservation and restoration plan.
6. Oppose AB 1740 unless amended to exclude alcohol-serving non-restaurant establishments.
7. Waive LUPC review of four minor residential/ADU projects, without prejudice.
8. Request non-discretionary density bonus and coastal exemption projects appear on CNC reports.
9. Request written explanations from BOE and Planning on 1209 Preston Way SHRA compliance.
10. Recommend denial of Bellagio Carwash at 2499 Lincoln Blvd.
11. Recommend approval of three SFDs at Garfield/Van Buren, conditioned on native landscaping and varied design.

12. Recommend approval of duplex-to-condo conversion at 20 17th Ave, as proposed.
13. Recommend approval of 710 SF addition at 2429 Eastern Canal, as proposed.
14. Recommend denial of roof deck at 27 Ketch; request code enforcement.
15. Request City Planning require ADU Acknowledgement form for all ADU applications.
16. Support SB 79 Implementation Option C1, conditioned on setback, notification, and incentive safeguards.
17. Approve February 2026 Monthly Expenditure Report.
18. Approve \$600 NPG to Reducing Animal Stress.
19. Approve \$5,000 NPG to Venice Heritage Museum.
20. LUPC Committee Member Appointment.
21. Request NPS extend LA Coastal Study comment period; require community engagement before final recommendations.
22. Adopt Rules & Elections Committee proposed Bylaws amendments; submit to DONE by April 1, 2026.
23. Adopt stakeholder petition Bylaws amendments establishing representational area voting.
24. Adopt Finance Committee Bylaws amendment clarifying Budget & Finance Committee responsibilities.
