

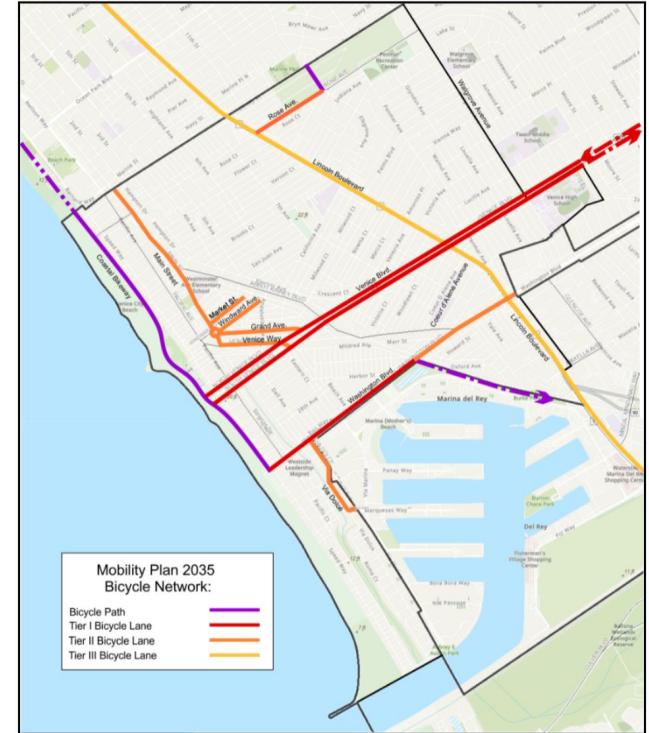

The purpose of this survey is to converge on a Bikeway Network Proposal that serves the stakeholders of Venice and can be formally presented to the VNC board. Once the network is adopted, then next phase will be to assess what features (roadway markings etc.) will be needed to increase the safety of each link of the network. These recommendations may also need to go to the VNC. Finally, city agencies will have to agree and implement the recommended safety features over time.

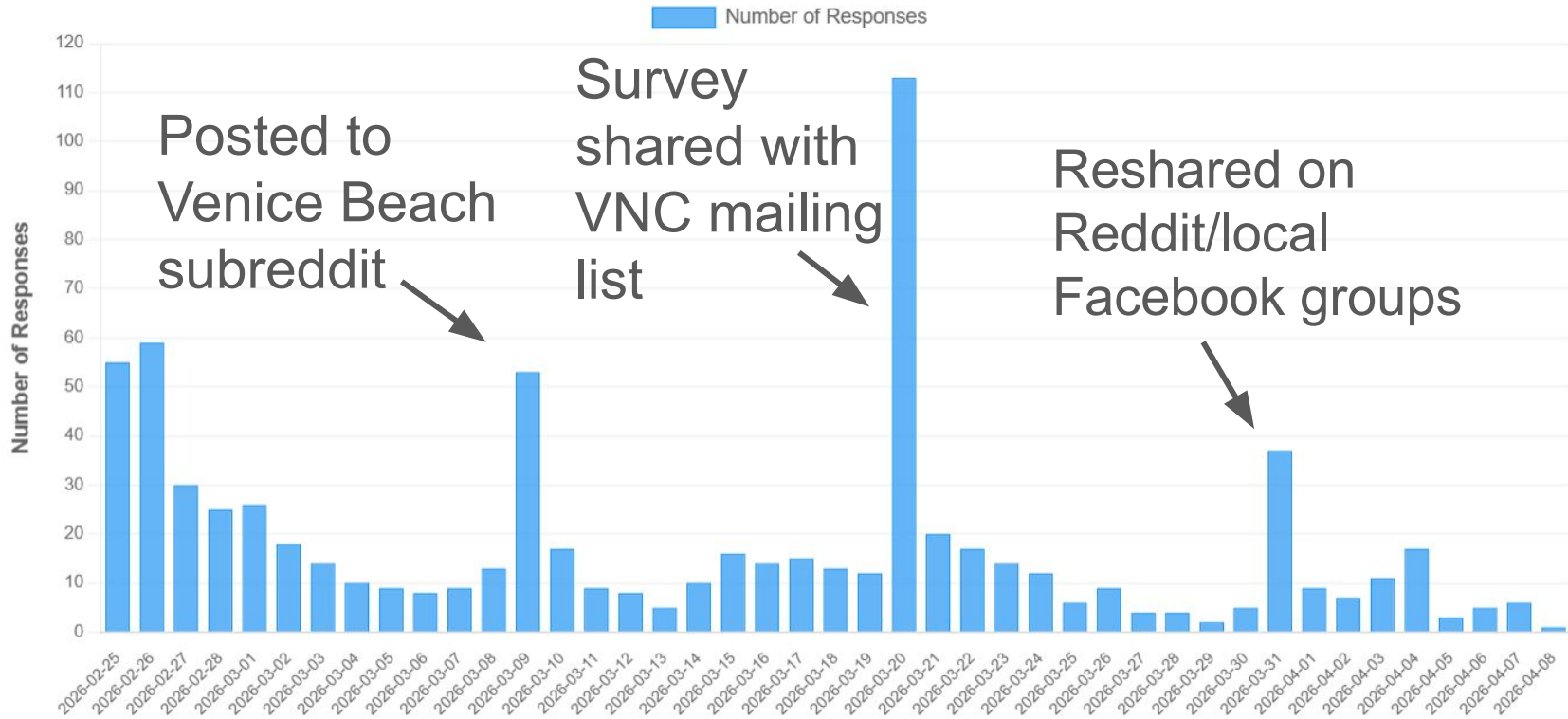

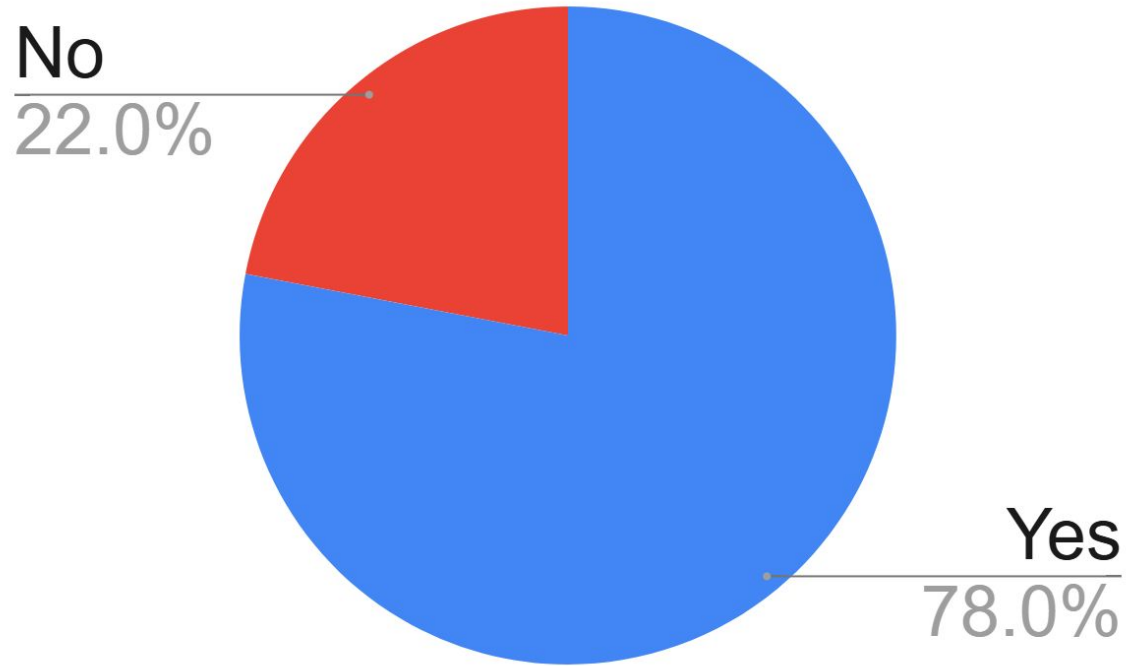

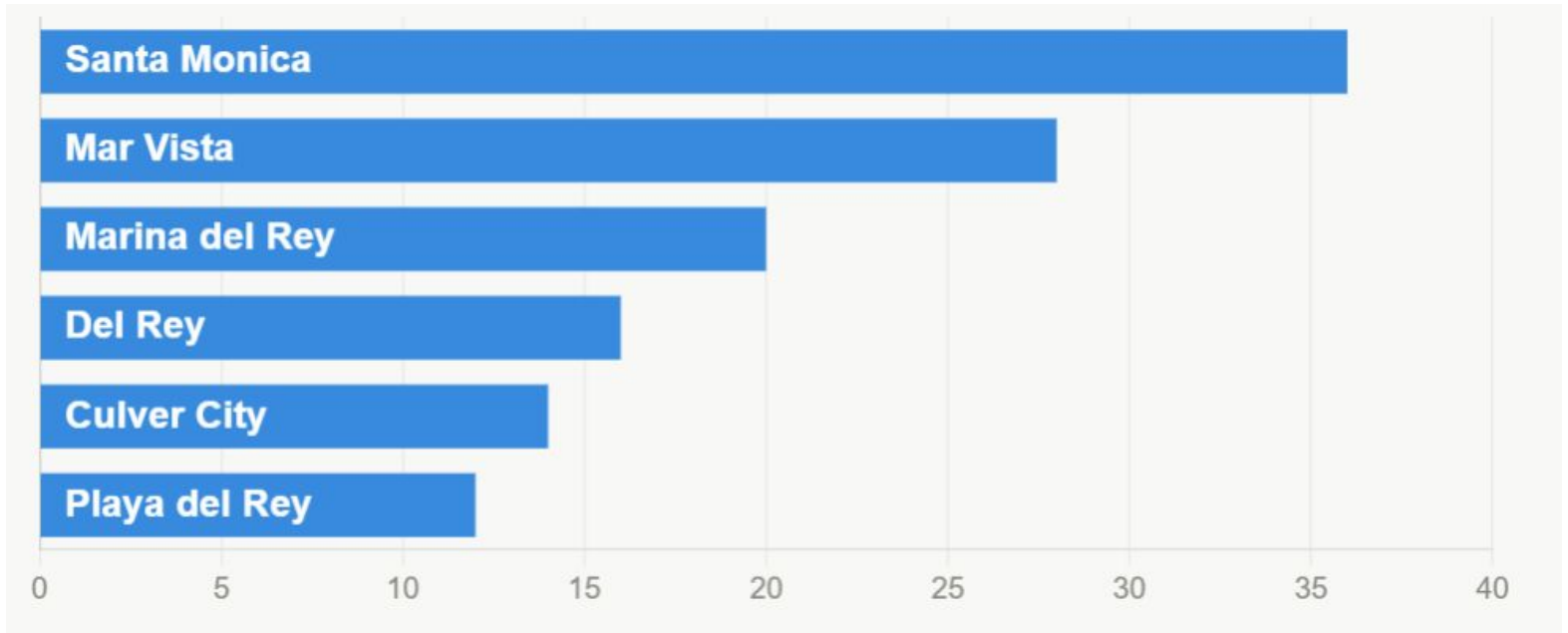

# Do you live or work in Venice?



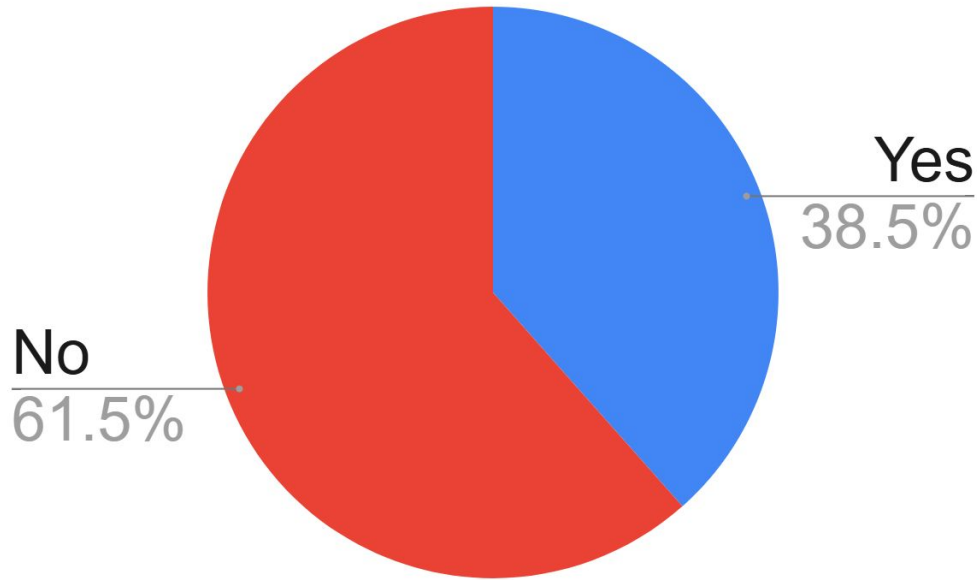
Three quarters of respondents live or work in Venice

# If you don't live or work in Venice, where do you live?



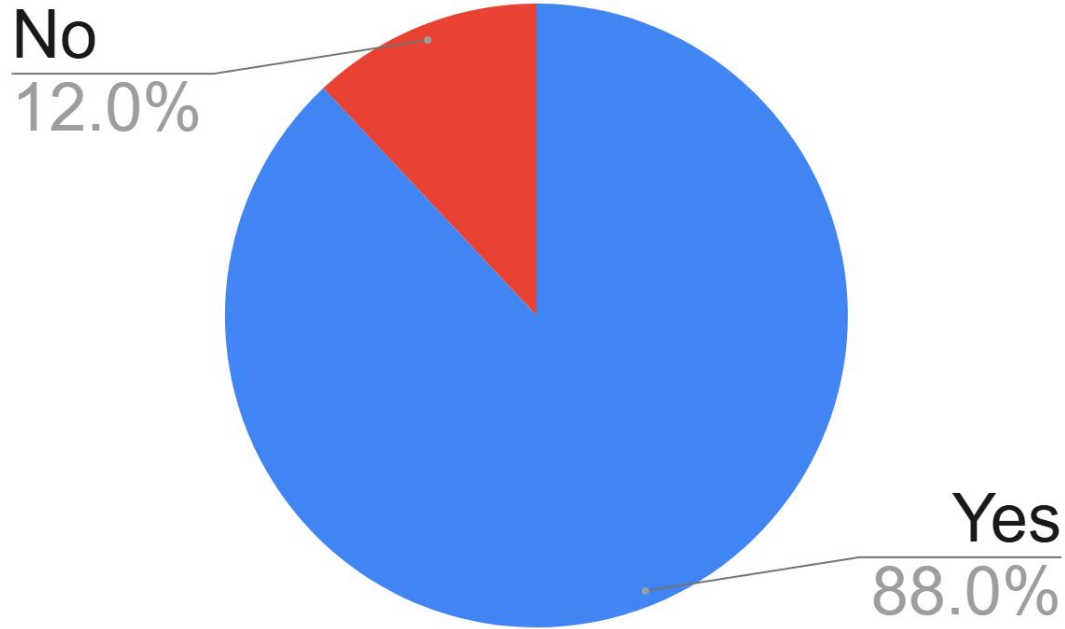
Top areas: Santa Monica, Mar Vista, Marina Del Rey

# Do you live on one of the proposed Venice Bikeway Network streets?



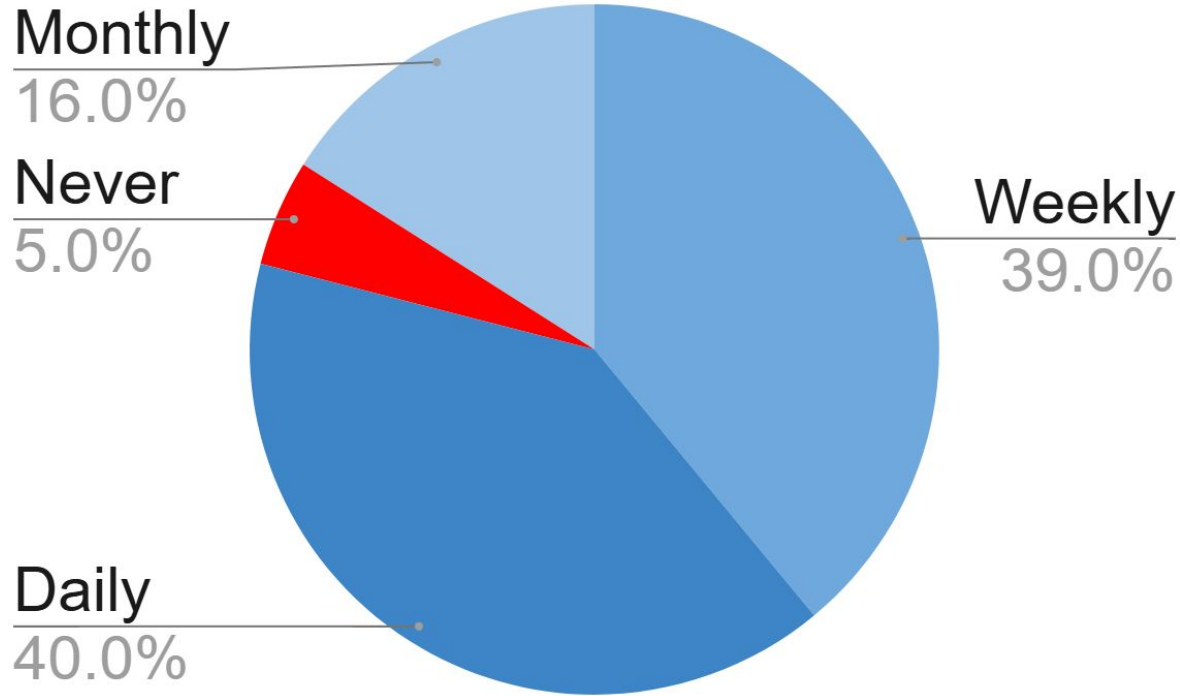
Impressive response from Venetians on bikeway streets

# Do you own a car?



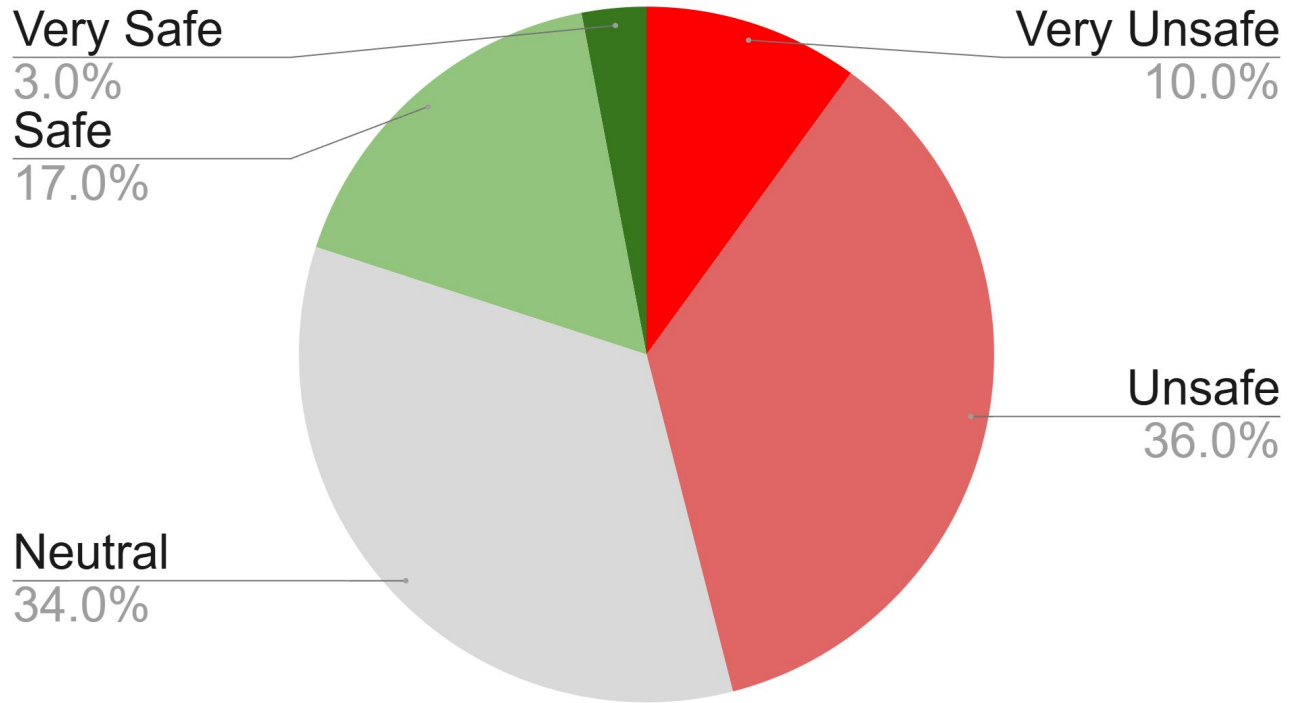
1 in 8 Venetians need non-car ways to travel

How often do you use a bicycle to get around Venice?



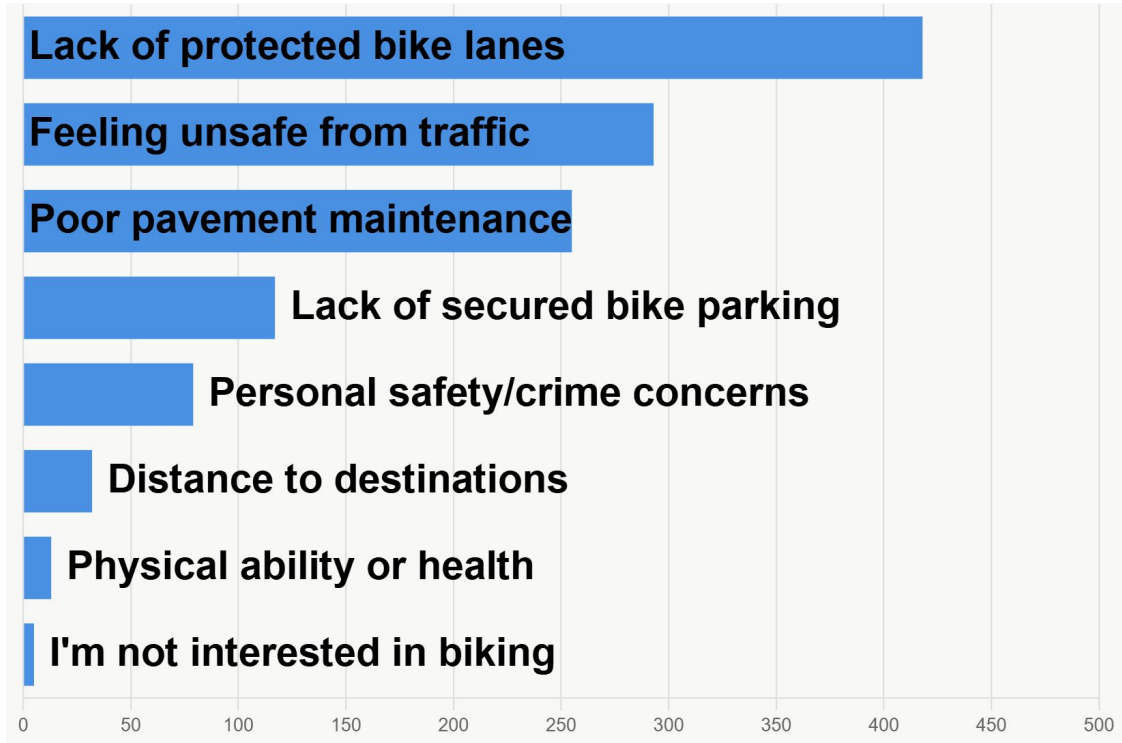
Respondents often use bicycles to get around

# How safe do you feel biking on the streets in Venice?



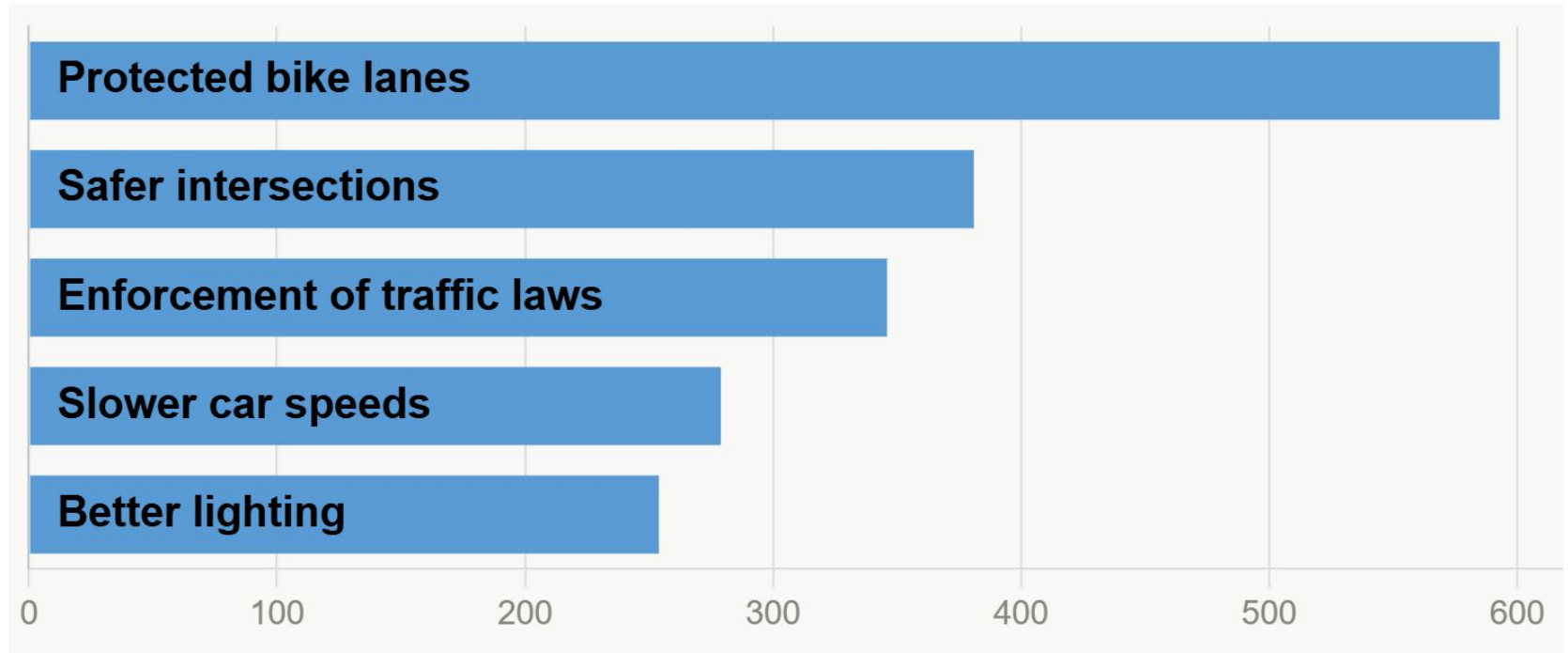
Even those that do cycle often feel unsafe

# What prevents you from biking more often?



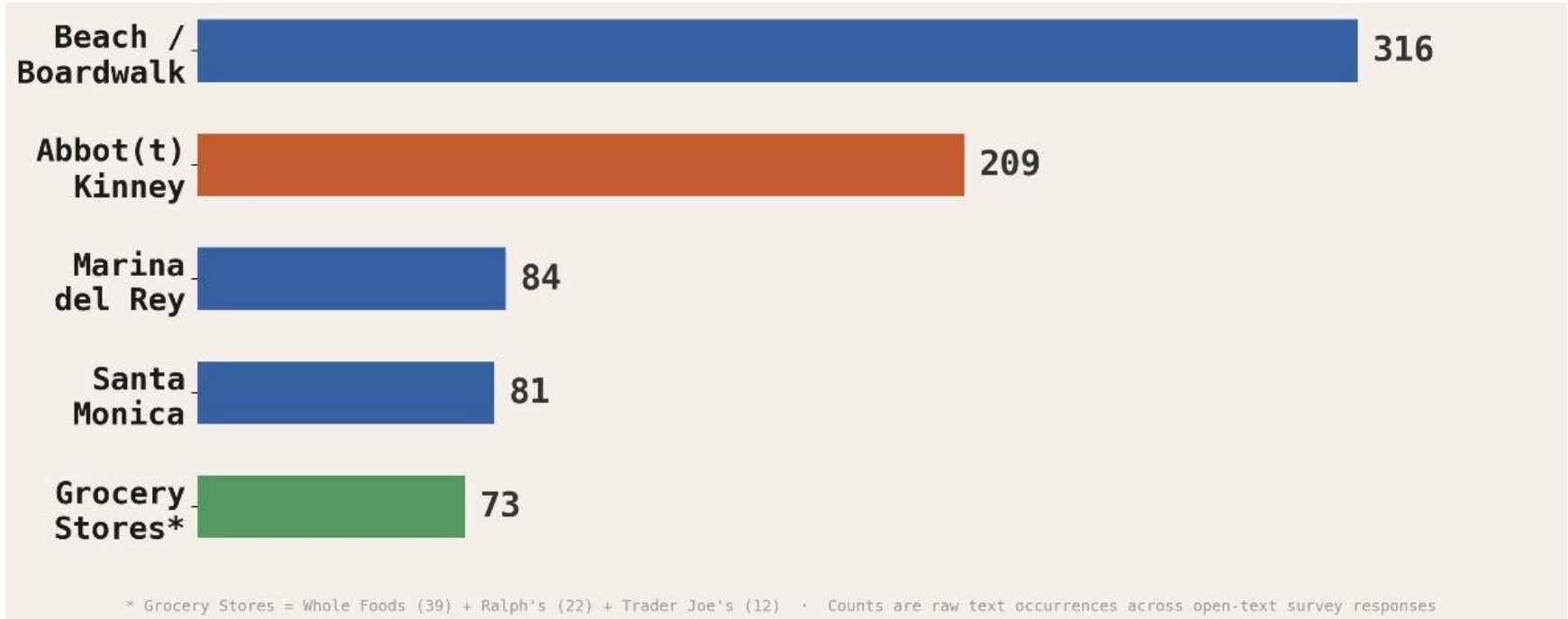
Lack of protected bike lanes is the #1 reason

# Which conditions would make you feel safer?



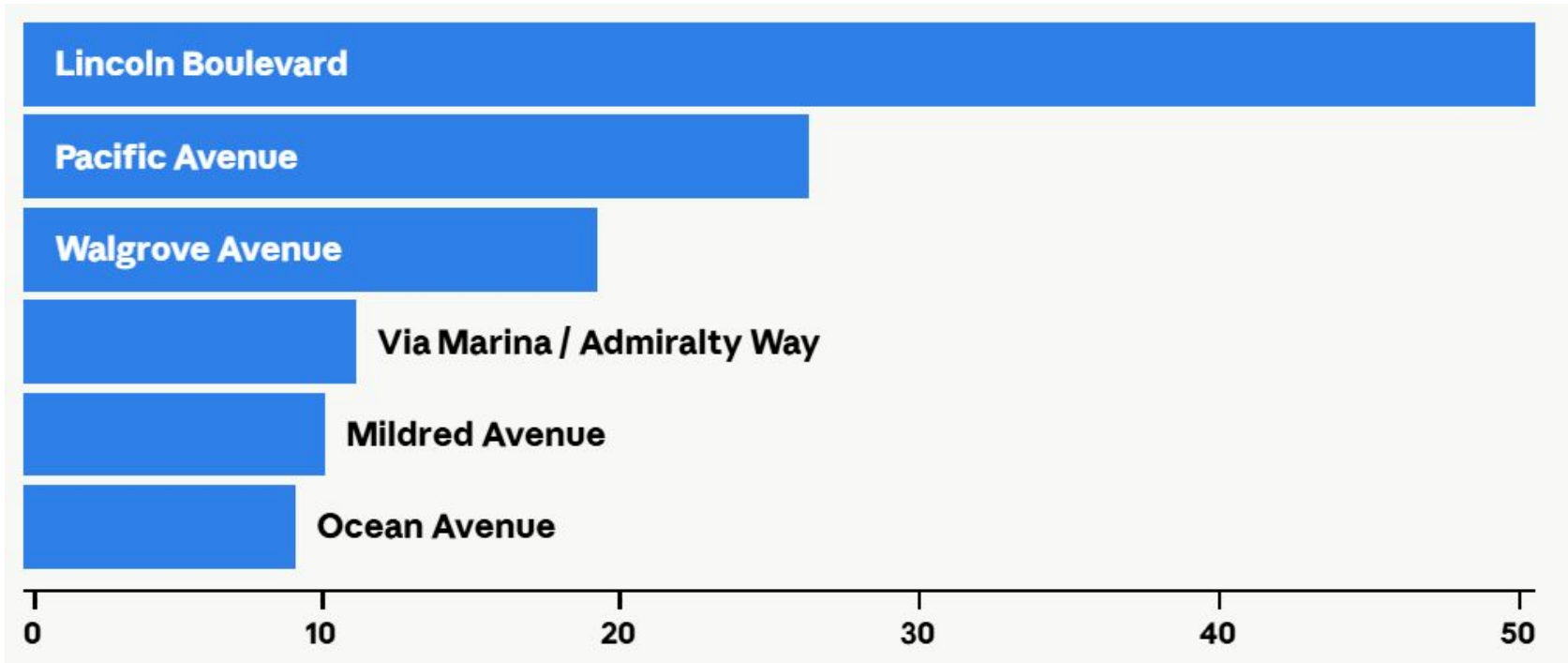
Crossing major intersections safely is also a major concern

# Summary of Comments

## Top Upgrade Requests:

- Washington Boulevard - Physically protected bike lanes is the most requested upgrade
- Venice Boulevard - Upgrade its full length to protected bike lanes
- Major Intersections - Make intersections safer for cyclists, Lincoln Blvd and Pacific Avenue, especially, where bikeways cross them

# Summary of Comments

## Other Notable Themes

- Venice's coastal bike path needs to be kept swept, widened, and pedestrians given their own walkway (like Santa Monica's section)
- Enforcement is needed of speeding vehicles along and in bikeways
- More maintenance is needed (pavement, potholes, path sweeping)
- Bike theft and is a major concern preventing more bike use

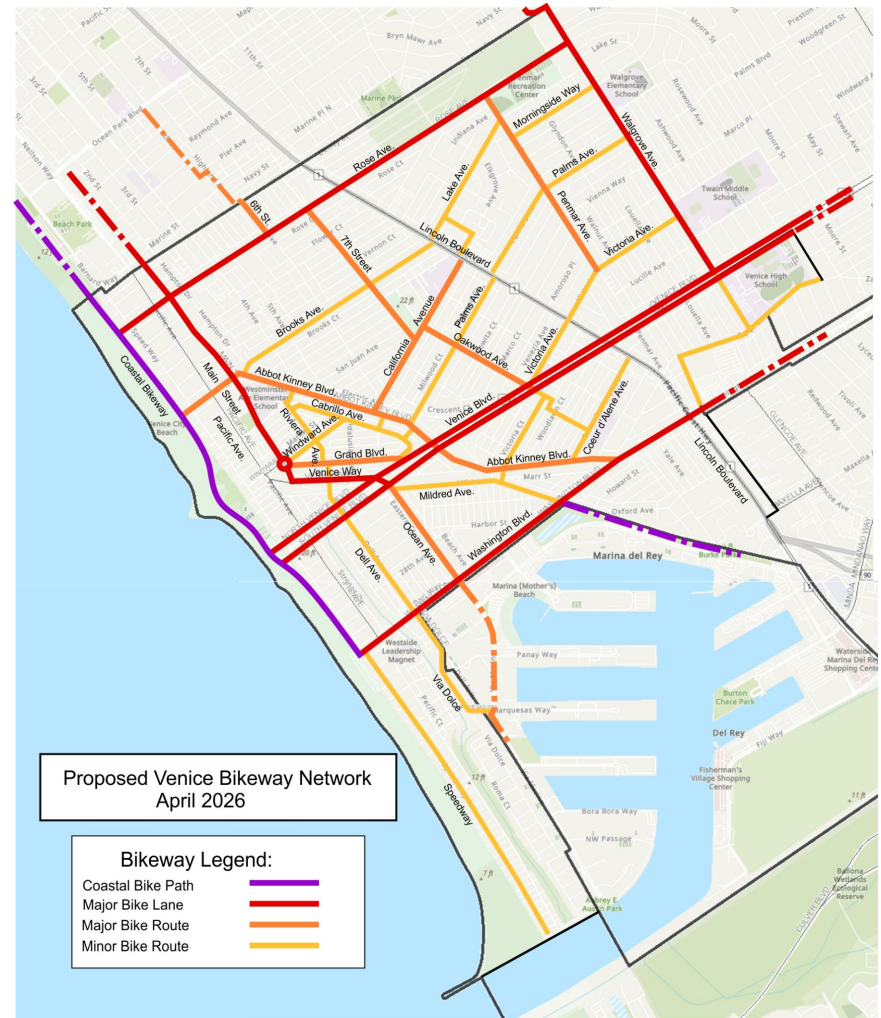

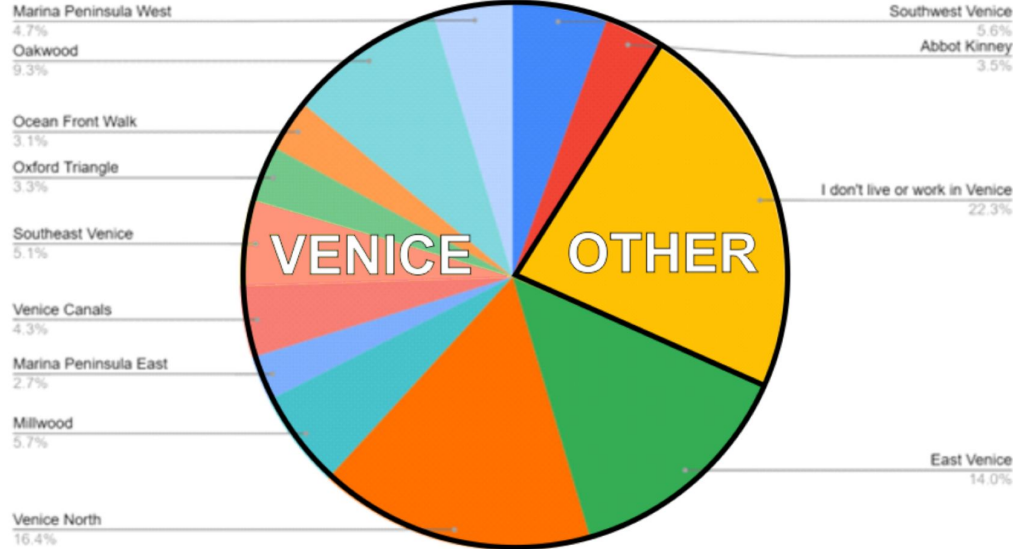
