**TITLE:** **New Standing Rule--Use of and Citation to AI Generated Content**

**PURPOSE:** To create transparency when arguments and emails sent to other Board Members have been generated by artificial intelligence (AI) and to allow Board Members to more effectively analyze and respond to issues raised using generative AI.

**BACKGROUND:** With the proliferation of AI and AI generated responses it is important to understand the sources of Board Member arguments and which of those arguments were created with generative AI. While AI can be a powerful aide, it should not be relied upon to create emails or arguments—and certainly not without disclosure. Thus, any email to the Board, other Board Members or a City agency that relies on AI should be clearly marked as generated by AI.

**THE MOTION:** With the proliferation of artificial intelligence (AI) and AI generated responses it is important to distinguish between the original work of a Board Member and responses created with generative AI. While AI can be a powerful aide, it should not be relied upon to create emails or arguments. Thus, any email to the Board, other Board Members, or any City oversight agency that has been generated using AI, must be **clearly** flagged as “*Generated by AI*” with a footnote that indicates clearly both which LLM (Large Language Model) was used to generate the response as well as the prompt or process used.
