OUTREACH BUSINESS CARDS

Motion: Passed at July 14th Meeting

The VNC Board approves the purchase of additional VNC Business Cards. These cards will match the current generic design and information with the addition of the Outreach Chair's name, direct email (Outreachchair@venicenc.org), and phone number displaying the VNC logo design. The total expenditure is not to exceed \$50.00

Background:

The VNC currently has generic business cards made available at the VNC Outreach table. Due to the large number of community events the Outreach team attends and the thousands of stakeholders we interface with throughout the year, having pre-printed cards with the Outreach Chair's name and direct contact information would significantly improve efficiency and engagement, eliminating the need to write these details out manually.

RV'S PARKED ON THE STREETS IN VENICE TOWN HALL

Motion: Passed at July 14th Meeting

The VNC Board approves holding an In Person "RVs Parked on the Streets in Venice Town Hall," as previously approved in the previous fiscal year utilizing a budget not to exceed \$1,000. These funds will be used for reasonable and necessary event related expenses, including location or room costs, equipment rentals such as tables and chairs, security support, decorum signage to set a friendly tone, location staffing, and very light refreshments such as water and protein bars. VNC approves necessary budget adjustment if needed.

Background:

Due to strong Stakeholder desire, the RV Town Hall originally scheduled for Spring 2026 but postponed due to unavailability of presenters to be rescheduled for Fall 2026. This Town Hall is presented by several VNC Committees: Parking, Transportation & Infrastructure, Homelessness & Public Health & Safety facilitated by the Outreach Committee. This educational forum brings together community stakeholders, city representatives, subject matter experts, and Neighborhood Council committees to examine the impacts of RV living on all parties involved, including housed residents, RV residents, local businesses, public health, and neighborhood safety. The purpose of the Town Hall is to provide clear, factual information about what actions can and cannot legally be taken, how enforcement and services function in practice, and where legal and operational constraints exist. The discussion will also acknowledge lessons learned from pilot programs used in other communities, with the goal of supporting informed dialogue, setting realistic expectations, and creating a shared understanding grounded in law, lived realities, and compassion

The VNC Board approves the purchase of 4 Banner Patches announcing the Tsunami Faire and Tsunami Walking Drill occurring in Fall 2026 or Spring 2027. These patches will be affixed to our reusable VNC branded banners and placed in highly visible Venice locations such as Oakwood Recreation Center, Penmar Park, The Palm Trees at Abbott Kinney/Venice Boulevard and Westminster Park or other locations within that proximity. Total costs included additional duct tape not to exceed \$295.00
