MISSING IN THE MIDDLE LA

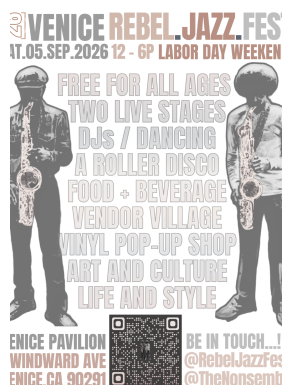
