Detailed Project Description -

Outreach has been made and will continue to be provided through the Verdant Venice Group's weekly work sessions which are on all Saturday mornings throughout Venice.

Implementation of Shade: All of the trees planted will, in time, provide ample shade to their surrounds. The goal of this entire project is to add to the local canopy and biodiversity.

Who and What is the Verdant Venice Group?

Verdant Venice Group (VVG) is a group of local of volunteers who work weekly on projects to add drought-tolerant canopy and native plants in public spaces, schools and parks throughout Venice. We incorporate education and encourage stewardship of neighbors, including smart watering and planting practices, alternatives to lawns, and stress the value of native trees and under-story plants to create and sustain biodiversity. Founded ten years ago, VVG has grown to over 150 individuals. We have planted and continue to care for over 780 trees along dozens of streets, public parking lots, a library, four parks, and three schools. In addition to their own neighborhood, we have inspired and been mentors to other community groups seeking support in CD11 such as Mar Vista, West LA Sawtelle, Pacific Palisades, and Del Rey.

Our planting events involve volunteers of all ages in the beautification and appreciation of our neighborhood. By inspiring people with the beauty, necessity, and understanding of our natural world and the importance of our local natural resources, we promote the idea that protecting our watershed and our natural environment is both an individual and collective responsibility. Our volunteer group and other friends and neighbors donate their time toward the labor of planting and caring for these trees for up a minimum of 5 years.

In addition to their beauty, trees have been shown to provide a wide variety of important benefits such as shade in a warming climate and air purification which is especially necessary under the flight path of the SM airport. Young people in underserved communities are especially susceptible to lung damage from air pollution. Tree canopy has also been shown to lead to a decrease in crime and improved learning in school children. Trees provide habitat for butterflies and local and migrating birds. Additionally, the knowledge gained from our projects will help inform the City and our community about our unique native trees and will create a market for these trees so that procurement

and initial care is not so time intensive. Beneficiaries are neighbors and businesses interested, low-income apartment dwellers, local school children, and public agencies who lack funds for plant replacement or maintenance.



Verdant Venice Group planting events involve community members of all stripes and many partnerships.

The project is a good investment since it builds on an already existing structure to improve highly trafficked streets that are deteriorating, and creates on-going education to ensure continual tree care. The project builds community by involving volunteers of all ages in the beautification and appreciation of the community. By inspiring people with the beauty and understanding of our natural world and the importance of our local natural resources, we will promote the idea that protecting our watershed is both an individual and collective responsibility.

Our work is only possible due to the support and hard work of the Venice community and our partners, Recreation and Park, LADOT, Urban Forestry, and Venice Neighborhood Council.

GROUP EFFORT

How the volunteers behind the Verdant Venice Group have helped make their Los Angeles neighborhood a seaside haven for native plants

In 2018, Isabelle Duvivier, an architect and expert in sustainable urban design, moved to a street in Venice with no trees on it. For a lifelong native plant enthusiast and member of the CNPS Los Angeles/Santa Monica Mountains Chapter, this was an untenable situation. So, she says, "I started figuring out how to get trees planted in our community." Duvivier knew that Noël Johnston, who was a neighborhood councilmember at the time, shared her interest in native plants. The two paired up to form a tree-planting working group. After placing trees on Duvivier's street, they decided to keep going, collaborating with the city to install native plants at the local Mar Vista Gardens housing project. They called their new project the Verdant Venice Group (VVG).

Plantings along Third Avenue in Venice offer a vision of a brighter urban future imagined by the native plant enthusiasts of the Verdant Venice Group. Every road verge, ditch, and inch of viable soil is fully populated with native plants, including Hooker's evening primrose (*Oenothera elata* ssp. *hookeri*) and California poppy (*Eschscholzia californica*), pictured at left. Other nearby plantings include coast live oak (*Quercus agrifolia*), Palmer's mallow (*Abutilon palmeri*), black sage (*Salvia mellifera*), white sage (*Salvia apiana*), and lacy phacelia (*Phacelia tanacetifolia*).

Duvivier immediately started recruiting friends, neighbors, and even strangers to volunteer. When Venice real estate agent Janin Paine stepped outside one morning to find a friend walking down her street with Duvivier, a partnership was born. "Isabelle just looked at me and said, 'You need some trees in front of your house,'" fondly recalls Paine, a member of CNPS's San Luis Obispo

Chapter, who became fast friends with Duvivier and eventually joined VVG as its volunteer director of marketing and development.

Since that day, Duvivier and Paine have collaborated with a growing roster of volunteers to plant native species throughout the neighborhood they love. Duvivier says she has always been a "native plant person," an interest that began when she took a botany class at a local college, where students took group trips into the Santa Monica Mountains to create native plant books. She says it's important to bring native plants out of

the limited spaces of nature preserves and back onto city streets across Venice and beyond.

In their work with VVG, Duvivier and Paine have surrounded un-air-conditioned housing projects with shade-providing trees like coast live oak (*Quercus agrifolia*) and California bay laurel (*Umbellularia californica*). They have restored dunes along Venice's iconic Ocean Front Walk, removing invasive grasses and planting erosion-fighting species like dune primrose (*Oenothera deltoidea*) and yellow sand verbena (*Abrona latifolia*) along the famous pathways where roller skaters dance to '90s hip-hop and tourists snap pictures of palm trees by the beach. They have transformed the streets surrounding the original Gold's Gym with plants like dark star ceanothus (*Ceanothus 'Dark Star'*) and California goldenrod (*Solidago velutina* ssp. *californica*), also planting gardens in two schools and four parks. Flora joined the Verdant Venice Group on one of their regular weekend workdays as they teamed up to transform the landscape, like their mission statement puts it, "one tree at a time."

It's like a little ritual—my cousins come to my house for a sleepover and then we get in the garden together and get our hands dirty." 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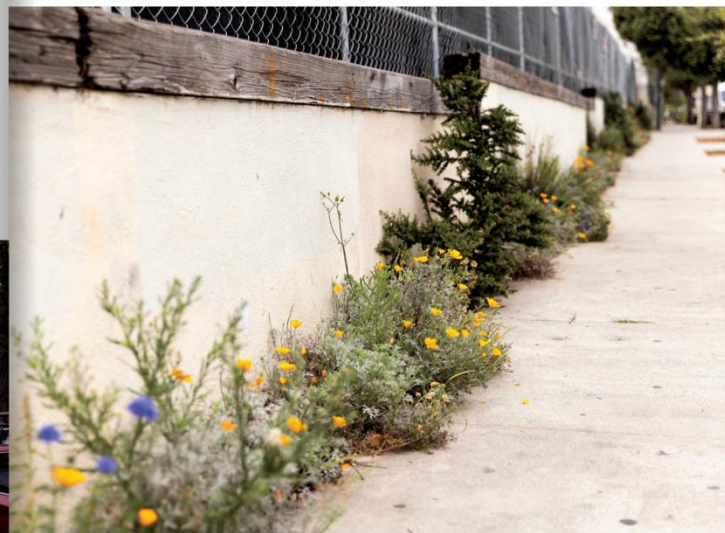

Faena says that VVG's work makes the bustling Venice streets more inviting, supporting the local merchants and storefronts he represents.

Coastal California poppy (*Eschscholzia californica* var. *maritima*) on the Penmar Golf Course provide essential shelter for native pollinators. At night, when the petals of the poppies close, male "bachelor bees" seek shelter from the elements and predation inside a makeshift golden sleeping bag. They wake with the sun to forage—and pollinate—once more.



As the dog park workday drew to a close, Paine's boyfriend Luis Gaona, a member of the Yaqui Nation, led the group in a ceremony to bless the new plantings. The assembled volunteers gathered around a newly planted coast live oak (*Quercus agrifolia*) and, at left, California buckeye (*Aesculus californica*) as Gaona provided handfuls of masa (or cornmeal) to toss onto the mulch. He explained that the masa would serve as a sacred offering of blessing, protection, and reciprocity, a prayer that the tree and their community would thrive. "We are all seeds that sprout into trees," Gaona says. "And today, we ask for the Creator's blessing, for the seeds, and for ourselves."

Elegant clarkia (*Clarkia unguiculata*) and Hooker's evening primrose (*Oenothera elata* ssp. *hookeri*), both pictured at right, thrive alongside toyon (*Heteromeles arbutifolia*) and coast live oak (*Quercus agrifolia*) in the narrow bed next to a wall on Sunset Avenue. The road verge features mugwort (*Artemisia douglasiana*), creek monkeyflower (*Erythranthe guttata*), common rush (*Juncus patens*), and yerba mansa (*Anemopsis californica*). Duvivier says that the team at VVG is currently focused on mastering the art of passive watering: the beds here, for example, are irrigated by groundwater pumped out of a nearby parking garage twice a day. "Planting trees is easy to do," she says. "The hard part is actually getting the trees cared for and watered." Fortunately, Venice is uniquely positioned at the bottom of the watershed, capturing stormwater that flows down through the city to the sea. Duvivier says that expanding the signature VVG approach to include these greater environmental factors will be key to the organization's ongoing evolution.



On the west side of Third Avenue—behind the original Gold's Gym location, where Duvivier and Paine both train—California poppies (*Eschscholzia californica*), Hooker's evening primrose (*Oenothera elata*), and globe gilia (*Gilia capitata*) bloom from a few inches of soil between the sidewalk and a wall. Across the street, the VVG leaders pointed out a tree whose leaves had been completely denuded by mourning cloak caterpillars. "We're very conscious about pollinators and which plants attract them," Paine adds. "We don't often plant willows because they need water, but we planted one here because it was always a very wet spot and it was just covered in caterpillars. They devoured it!" This whole-biome strategy influences their approach throughout Venice, prompting creative solutions to fit native plants anywhere and everywhere they can.

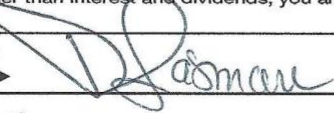
