9B Testing for E. coli, Other Pathogens and Hazardous Substances from Stormwater Runoff into the Ocean at Rose Avenue (Soledad Ursua on behalf of the Public Health & Safety Committee)

MOTION: The VNC calls upon the Los Angeles City Council to work with appropriate governmental agencies such as the Los Angeles County Health Department and NGO's such as Heal the Bay to implement weekly testing for E. coli, other pathogens and hazardous chemicals, in the beach water, at the stormwater outlet and in the surrounding sand at the Rose Avenue stormwater outlet; to report the results to the public each month, and to put up public warning signs at the site if any hazards are found in the testing and/or fence off the area, as necessary to protect public health. 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12A Resolution to Retain Weekly Street Sweeping Services Near the Boardwalk and Commercial Corridors at Venice Beach (soledad.urusa@venicenc.org)
