 - i. *Whereas bicycle chop shops have become an increasing hazard to residents, businesses and visitors and a blight to the community; therefore the NHC proposes that the VNC recommend to Councilman Bonin, the LA City Council, the LA District Attorney and the LAPD to create an ordinance modeled on the City of San Francisco's Public Works Code Order 203-17 which prohibits the assembly, disassembly, sale, offer of sale, distribution, offer of distribution, or storage of bicycles and bicycle parts on the public right-of-ways, under certain conditions and with certain exceptions, and authorizes the removal and seizure of bicycles and bicycle parts following issuance of a notice of violation.*
