- 1. The meeting was called to order at 8:15 a.m. Present were Hugh Harrison, Sylvia Aroth, and Ivan Spiegel.
- 2. The agenda was approved.
- 3. The minutes for the meeting of April 7, 2014, were approved unanimously. [IS, SA]
- 4. Ivan Spiegel reported on the status of the community improvement projects. The deadline for completion has passed. There will be a special meeting of the committee to discuss next year's applications.
- 5. The expenditure reports for March 22 through April 21, 2014 [Exhibit A], were approved unanimously. [IS, SA]
- 6. The committee voted unanimously to propose that the Venice NC allocation \$1000 for the Congress of Neighborhoods and \$500 for the Budget Advocates from this year's budget.
- 7. The funding requests for May [Exhibit B] were approved unanimously. [IS, SA]
- 8. There was a motion to reallocate \$2,000 to the Community Barbecue from the unspent neighborhood and board community improvement projects. The motion passed unanimously. [IS, SA]
- 9. The committee voted unanimously to propose that the Venice NC adopt a 2014-2015 budget [Exhibit C]. The motion passed unanimously. [IS, SA]
- 10. The committee voted unanimously to propose that the Venice NC adopt a 2014-2015 Strategic Plan [Exhibit D]. The motion passed unanimously. [IS, SA]
- 11. It was agreed to move the June meeting from June 3 because of the statewide election to June 6.
- 12. The meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
