PROJECT DESCRIPTION (Include how many stakeholders will be working on this project.) (Maximum 500 words)

In December 2009, the VNC (then called Grass Roots Venice) approved an installation of a video projector and screen at the Oakwood Rec Center. The motion was approved and funds were paid to the Dept. of Rec and Parks to purchase the overhead screen. The following year, GRVNC did not have the funds to pay for the projector. This project has sat dormant ever since but the need remains.

In 2019, James Murez, VNC Board Member asked the Board for permission to pursue this project. The Board granted him permission to follow up with LA City Rec and Parks to determine what would be involved at this time to complete the project. Last month, Annamaria Galbraith ([annamaria.galbraith@lacity.org](mailto:annamaria.galbraith@lacity.org)) from Rec and Parks replied copying Keith Rice; George Francisco; Gonzalo Manrique, that Rec and Parks personnel would do the installation of the projector assuming VNC would purchase it along with the misc. components described below.

Once this project is completed, the VNC Land Use and Planning Committee along with other VNC committees will be able to use the projector and existing screen for video (computer) presentations. This will allow members of the audience attending the meetings to see what presenters are showing. This will be particular beneficial to the public for LUPC meetings where construction projects often include multiple page documents that are not copied for the public and shared in with print that is so small it becomes very hard to read.

The Rec and Parks office at the center has also commented they have several childrens programs that often could use this equipment if it becomes available. This project will benefit the entire community once it is completed.
