


Recent Results

Transportation – 84 state-ofthe-art, natural gas powered commuter buses have been ordered to replace the City's older diesel coaches currently in use. One "clean" coach bus can take 49 passenger cars off the road and provide a lower carbon foot print per passenger mile than any other mode of transportation.

Housing – Outdoor space upgrades are underway at three affordable housing communities: Ramona Gardens, Rancho San Pedro and Mar Vista Gardens. Playgrounds will be updated with safer equipment and a soft floor. Common areas will be enhanced with park benches and picnic tables, and walkways will be lined with new trees and shrubs, creating a more pedestrian-friendly environment.


