### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This entertaining 60-page history, culture & arts children's workbook, "Discovering My Venice, Our City's Art, Culture and Heritage," will be distributed to approximately 2000 school students and youth organizations located in Venice and adjacent areas (considered stakeholders). The left side of each 2-page spread will offer a variety of fun facts about Venice's rich history, culture and arts, and on the right side will be a corresponding educational activity for children to get involved with. Activities are being designed by children, 8- 12 years of age, from the Venice Area.

The educational workbook will explore numerous subjects unique to Venice, including the historic canals, murals, traditions, arts, architecture and landmarks; also included will be the contributions of various ethnic groups, including Native Americans. Each topic will have one page of text and a corresponding activity, such as puzzles, word games, maps, and designs for the kids to complete. A wonderful feature of this book is that students, teachers and youth groups will help in developing the activities. Children, 8- 12 years of age, will receive a free copy of the book. We will be printing 2000 copies to distribute.

We have already begun reaching out to the schools, youth organizations, as well as after-school & park programs, and have received enthusiastic responses.

Teachers from eight elementary & charter schools (St. Mark, Walgrove Elementary, Beethoven Elementary, Broadway Elementary, Westminster Elementary, Ocean Charter, Global Awareness Magnet, Venice Lutheran) and two youth group organizations (Oakwood Recreation, 826LA), all stakeholders in Venice, are already working with their students on creating fun-filled and learning activities for the book.

Three Venice Historical Society members, also Venice residents, have donated their time to create, design, research, write and produce the *Discovering My Venice* workbook. A Venice artist has given us permission to use his illustration for the book's cover.

The educational <u>goal</u> of the "Discovering My Venice, Our City's Art, Culture and Heritage" workbook project is to expose young people to their local history, art and culture in an entertaining and informative way and to encourage them to be aware of the various cultures and art that surround them, to appreciate their unique environment and their rich history.

The <u>purpose/benefit</u> of this workbook project is to give our youth a chance to participate, learn, appreciate and get involved with the book's production by helping design the many activities included in "Discovering My Venice, Our City's Art, Culture and Heritage." 


