Are vehicles ILLEGALLY PARKING OVERNIGHT on your block?

Solution: Consider the Overnight Parking District (OPD) petition.

What is an OPD? An Overnight Parking District prohibits parking without a permit at night only—from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Parking at all other times will remain as posted. OPDs will not restrict public access to the beach or residents' ability to have overnight guests.

Why do we need OPDs? Some Venice blocks have a chronic problem with illegally parked vehicles. They have a negative impact on the quality of life in our neighborhoods that includes the loss of:

- Parking for residents.
- Access to surrounding sidewalk areas.
- Feeling safe outside one's house.

How does a block become eligible for an OPD? 66% of the dwelling units on a street segment must sign the official OPD petition. Only one resident per dwelling unit can sign. Ultimately, the Venice Neighborhood Council (VNC) and Councilmember Bill Rosendahl will use this information to implement OPD areas per municipal code 80.54 (www.lacity.org).

What would it cost?

- **\$15** yearly for a resident permit
 - (max 3 per dwelling unit)
- **\$10** for a 4-month renewable visitor permit (max 2 per dwelling unit)
- **\$1** for a 1-night guest permit (max 10 yearly per dwelling unit)
