8 Statement of How the Event Will Benefit the Community

8A. A Community Benefit

The Oakwood area and all of Venice will benefit from this project by providing the means and venue to develop community pride. The Oakwood area continues to suffer from a very negative image due to gangs, drugs, poverty, racial strife, and extremities of income. However, Oakwood is a strong rooted community with the greatest diversity in all of Venice. By taping into our strengths we can mitigate our weaknesses. The park is the hub of our community and in times past has been a place where families used to congregate. This event can bring about a renaissance of the park as a place of community connection. Revitalizing the use of a vital community resource is an appropriate role of a Neighborhood Council. Carolyn Rios did extensive leafleting and conducted a Visioning meeting for the Oakwood-Milwood Area Committee of the VNC. In this meeting there was a strong consensus on the need for events that promote community pride and the opportunity to connect with neighbors. A strong friendly community will also enhance the safety issues that are paramount in this neighborhood.

8B. Community Outreach for the VNC

The Oakwood BBQ is a great opportunity for VNC Outreach. People will have an opportunity to register to vote. Candidates and Board Members can socialize and interact with the community in a more personal one-on-one manner. We will have a stage and microphone for musicians and candidates will have the opportunity to speak. As our event is before the nomination deadline, it is also an opportunity to solicit nominations from the community. The Oakwood-Milwood area represents the largest population in the Venice Specific Plan, has the highest minority population, and the lowest median income. Outreach in this neighborhood is essential to maintaining a diverse membership in the VNC. If we were to create a list of places that desperately needed outreach to satisfy the diversity mandate, surely the Oakwood-Milwood area would be at the top of the list. This event will be a pilot project that can create templates which other areas can use to model their outreach events upon. In this way, this event has the capacity to benefit the entire community of Venice, long after it has reached its successful conclusion.
