#### PROCEDURE FOR COMPLAINTS AGAINST THE GRVNC

#### From the GRVNC Bylaws:

"Grievance: Any GRVNC Community Stakeholder who is adversely affected by a decision of the GRVNC may submit a written Grievance to any member of the Board of Officers. The Board of Officers (or a sub-committee thereof, if so designated by the Board) shall review the Grievance at either a regular Board of Officers meeting or a specially called meeting. The complainant shall be notified no less than four (4) days prior to this meeting in order that she/he may attend. The Board shall resolve the Grievance or take appropriate action and shall advise the complainant of its determination."

## Complete Complaint Form

A complaint may be filed against the Grass Roots Venice Neighborhood Council by submitting a "Complaint Form" available from the GRVNC web page at www.grvnc.org/Grievance. The GRVNC complaint form may also be obtained by contacting the GRVNC Secretary via email at secretary@grvnc.org or by calling the GRVNC Infoline at 310.399.5515.

## Submit Complaint Form
