BRIEF PROJECT DESCRIPTION (50 WORDS OR LESS) Funds are needed to purchase a quantity of Safe-Trac G, a paintable coating material that has non-skid properties, which is to be applied by a licensed contractor to the tread surfaces of the Venice Canals' 9 walk-bridges. The tread surfaces of these bridges have become seriously eroded over the years due to the excessive foot traffic caused in great part because the Canals are a "Must See" tourist attraction. Currently, the condition of the walk-bridge treads make them a serious public safety hazard; several people have already severely hurt themselves after they slipped and fell as a result of the poorly dition of the walk surfaces on the bridges. PROJECT DESCRIPTION (Include how many stakeholders will be working on this project.) (Maximum 500 words)

Funds are needed to purchase a quantity of Safe-Trac G, a paintable coating material that has non-skid properties, which is to be applied by a licensed contractor to the tread surfaces of the Venice Canals' 9 walk-bridges. The tread surfaces of these bridges have become seriously eroded over the years due to the excessive foot traffic caused in great part because the Canals have become a "Must See" tourist attraction. Currently, the condition of the walk-bridge treads make them a <u>serious</u> public safety hazard; several people have already severely hurt themselves after they slipped and fell as a result of the poorly maintained condition of the walk surfaces on the bridges. (Please see the "before" photos on Page 5.A, attached hereto.)

In 2007, the City's Street Services Department, which has jurisdiction over the care and upkeep of the walk-bridges in the Canals, was notified of the deteriorating condition of the walk surfaces of these bridges. At that time, Street Services applied one coat of the Safe-Trac G material to several, but not ALL, of the walk-bridges. At best, it was the equivalent of a band-aid being applied to a broken arm. (Note: The manufacturer recommends a minimum of 2-3 applications of Safe-Trac G to ensure a safe, skid-free durable walking surface.)

Now, almost four years later, the 9 walk-bridges are in worse shape than ever, and have become very dangerous to navigate, especially when they are damp or wet (which is most mornings near the beach). What little non-slip coating was applied in 2007 has now almost completely worn away through general wear and tear, and is further aggravated by skate boards and roller blades, which has torn up the coating even further. Without any sort of protective coating, the wood plank treads are becoming splintered and destroyed. Unless they are refurbished now, it is only a matter of time before all the footbridges will need to be taken out of public use because they will be a significant public safety hazard.

This situation needs IMMEDIATE attention. Unfortunately, the City has experienced a huge financial shortfall and simply does not have the funding to take care of our Canal walk-bridges has they have done historically.

We respectfully urge the Venice Neighborhood Council, through its Community Improvement Funding program, to help us repair our 9 walk-bridges to ensure Venice stakeholders and the many visitors who visit the historic Venice Canals annually remain safe from harm.



The VCA is a neighborhood Association that has been proudly serving our community's needs for more than 32 years, since our founding in January 1975. Our mission has always been and continues to be to protect, preserve, and enhance our uniquely beautiful and historic community. Without a doubt, the one accomplishment we are most proud of to date is spearheading the rehabilitation and restoration of our historic Venice Canals, which was completed in 1993 through an assessment district with the City of Los Angeles.

Our Board consists of 11 community-elected Directors who serve staggered two-year terms. Approximately three-quarters of the almost 400 properties in the Canals are owned by VCA General Members. However, not all of our members are property owners — approximately 10% are "Friends of the Canals" - canal residents who are not property owners, and others residing outside of the Canals, who simply share a love and concern for the well-being of our unique community such as the Venice Heritage Foundation, Friends of the Venice Library, the Venice Chamber of Commerce, and the Venice Canals Foundation.

And our work in the community continues. In 2005, we "partnered" with the City's CB Grant program and the Voice of the Canals (a newly formed fellow-neighborhood association) and successfully completed our first CB Grant project – the "Gateway to the Historic Venice Canals" landscape project, which allowed us to create a beautiful entryway to the Canals as well as giving us the opportunity to commemorate the historical nature of the area with the installation of Los Angeles Cultural Affairs Historical Monument Plaque No. 270, which had previously been awarded to the VCA.

Other community-oriented projects the VCA has completed include, but are not limited to the following:

- * When needed, the VCA purchases and replaces the Atriplex (saltbush) plants, which serve as our "safety handrails" along the sidewalks. Through our Atriplex Adopt-A-Plant program, residents voluntarily nurture the newly purchased plants until they are ready for planting. In conjunction with the City, we are also responsible for the planting of environmentally appropriate trees in and around the Canals, and helped to rehabilitate the children's Linnie Canal Park (and Duck yard) on Dell Avenue, making it once again safe and enjoyable for both our children and the many species of migrating waterfowl that seasonally pass through the Canals community;
- * The VCA was instrumental in designing and installing unique directional signage to assist residents and visitors alike who wish to enjoy the Canals. The public signs offer directions and the "rules and regulations" of the Canals, to better protect wildlife and promote safety. In an effort to minimize debris in the community, we also purchased and installed the numerous trash receptacles you'll find conveniently placed around the Canals, and made arrangements with the City for the trash removal from them;
- * In keeping with our "recreational wetland environment" designation, the VCA worked with the City and Coastal Commission to develop a boat dock design specifically geared for the small boats that are permitted on our waterways.
- * For many years, the VCA sponsored a bi-annual Canal & Bridge Clean-up Day in which residents "adopted" each of our nine pedestrian and four vehicular bridges to clean and repaint. Ever mindful of environmental concerns, we now use only those paints and cleaning products that are friendly to our special wetland eco-system;
- * Another of our more important projects is the on-going protection and improvement of the water quality of the entire North Venice Canals waterway system. Sea water flows in and out of the Ballona Lagoon, which is an important true wetland preserve, through the County's tidal gates in the Marina. In an effort to stop contaminated street and storm drain runoff from entering the Lagoon, the City, working with the VCA, installed special filters on free flowing storm drains that empty into the Venice Canals. Additionally, to minimize street overflow runoff and unfiltered petroleum residue and other contaminants from flowing into our waterway, the VCA assisted residents with the installation of filtered drains in almost all of our access Courts and parking lots adjacent to the Canals.
