RE: Request for Traffic and Speed Data

At its regular meeting on march 20, 2012, The Venice Neighborhood Council passed the following motion requesting traffic and speed data:

MOTION: Whereas, the Venice Neighborhood Council is concerned about reports of accidents and near accidents between motorists, bicycles and pedestrians on Pacific Ave, north of Washington to the Santa Monica border; and on Washington Blvd. between Pacific Ave. and Ocean Ave., and Whereas, many of these incidents appear to involve excessive vehicle speed; Whereas, the Venice Neighborhood Council needs better data to fulfill its advisory role in making recommendations concerning traffic and traffic safety; Therefore, he is resolved, the Venice Neighborhood Council requests the Los Angeles

The Venice Neighborhood Council asks the Los Angeles Department of Transportation and LA City Council District 11 to partner with it to study and develop possible solutions to the traffic safety hazards along Pacific Ave. between Washington Blvd and the Santa Monica border
