RE: Request for a Crosswalk at Pacific Avenue and 25th Street in Venice

MOTION: Whereas, the Venice Canals Foundation created an ADA approved public Beach Access connecting the historic Venice Canals and the Venice Beach using \$1900 provided by Venice Neighborhood Council Community Improvement funding, and Whereas, the Culver City bus stops at 25th and Pacific and a crosswalk at that location would benefit bus riders, and

Whereas, members of the Venice Canals Foundation met with a representative of DOT in 2008, receiving assurances that implementing an ADA approved crosswalk at 25th and Venice would not be a problem;

Therefore, be it resolved, the Venice Neighborhood Council requests the City of Los Angeles to install a crosswalk at the intersection of Pacific and 25th Ave, crossing Pacific at the newly constructed ADA compliant beach access.
