Dear Mr. Mayor,

It has come to the attention of the Venice Neighborhood Council that in your proposed Budget, funding for gang intervention programs in Venice will be cut dramatically or even eliminated. We are being told this money would then be allocated to other areas of Los Angeles. Eliminating funding will eliminate ongoing, successful gang intervention programs that have reduced violence and personal loss in Venice.

We understand Venice is not considered a Gang Reduction Zone (GRZ) and the rationale we are hearing for this proposed funding cut is that all funds should be allocated to GRZs. We dispute this reasoning. Venice is not a GRZ because of the continued efforts of Venice 2000/H.E.L.P.E.R ALLIANCE which has been working the streets/gangs of Venice since 1999 to effect positive change. By cutting the funding of these intervention programs in the Venice area, we believe the success they have achieved could be lost and we could become a GRZ.

We ask you, Mr. Mayor, to please continue funding Venice 2000/H.E.L.P.E.R ALLIANCE area programs that have a track record of success in Venice and can be used as models in other communities.
