The Board of the Venice Neighborhood Council is writing this letter in support of improving the existing lighting and safety on Ocean Front Walk, starting now from North Venice Blvd up to Clubhouse and upgrading the four lights on Windward near Ocean front Walk.

Venice is the number one public tourist attraction in Southern California. As such it is an important job, revenue and tax generator for the city. The historic Windward area and Ocean Front Walk are key parts of Venice. These areas have over the past few years seen marked improvements by the city including those made to the park, skate board area and muscle beach. Added to this have been investments by private groups opening and improving restaurants and hotels, restoring historic murals and making other major improvements. Now the OFW is getting busy year round and into the night! Unfortunately, this area is plagued by illicit activity during the night.
